There were approximately 308 grants to 142 grant recipients, totaling \$4,406,618 during calendar year 2009. These grants were in the areas of Peace and reconciliation, Arts and Culture, Community Development and Education. They consisted of Donor advised US and Foreign grants and Non Donor advised US and Foreign grants

The Fund is guided by the 3 year Strategic Plan adopted by the Board and Executive Committee in 2008. This plan focuses on a number of elements under the overall title ‘The global Irish making a difference together’. In 2009, Kingsley Aikins concentrated on two key elements - the promotion of Philanthropy and Global Diaspora Strategies. In particular, two major publications were researched and produced. The first was The Ireland Funds’ Philanthropy and Fundraising Toolkit which was distributed extensively to the Irish nonprofit sector. He also spoke at a series of conferences and seminars and was the keynote speaker at an Ireland Funds conference in December. He met regularly with representatives of charities to help them with their fundraising strategies as well as to advise corporate bodies and government. The second publication was entitled A Comparative Review of Global Diaspora Strategies which researched how other countries connected with their Diasporas. Kingsley then made recommendations on Diaspora outreach for the Irish government to consider. As part of the research, visits were made to a number of other countries including India and Israel to look at global best practice and extensive desk research examined other models. The report was produced to coincide with the Irish government’s conference of the Irish Diaspora in Farnleigh. The report, which is available on The Ireland Funds’ website, has been extensively downloaded. Both these initiatives, as well as other activities, are part of The American Ireland Fund’s OBJECTIVE to provide technical and other services to assist in the professionalization of charitable organizations in Ireland and help organizations and individuals connect with the Irish Diaspora. The Diaspora report attracted much attention in Ireland at the Farnleigh Global Economic Conference and from governments elsewhere and, following a meeting in Belfast with U.S. Secretary of State Hillary Clinton towards the end of 2009, she subsequently announced that the U.S. State Department, with the help of The American Ireland Fund, would hold a conference to share best practices and smart ideas for engaging global Diaspora communities. Kingsley Aikins has been engaged with developing materials for this conference and involving governments, corporations, non-profits and academics. Kieran McLoughlin is responsible for implementing the three year strategic plan and the promotion of philanthropy. He liaises on a weekly basis with Irish nonprofit organizations who travel to the U.S. seeking advice about prospective donors-how to identify, connect with and make their case to them. He has also arranged a series of events enabling leading Irish charities to have a platform for their work. Equally, when in Ireland he also meets with nonprofit groups and advises them on approaching U.S. and Irish donors. He is involved also with the Fund’s Diaspora development program and works consistently with the Irish Government and the U.S. State Department. Other resources attributing to program services include the development of materials that report on the work of grant recipients. Communications include the organization’s a bi-annual magazine profiling grant recipients, the organization’s website, journals that detail grant recipient activities and a corporate brochure that is used to solicit support for grant recipients. The objective of these publications is to inform donors on the accomplishments of beneficiaries and to promote the same work to potential donors. Program services are also carried out by regional staff that visit and assess projects in order to represent those interests and to educate the public.

Support activities such as providing an education service to many of the organizations that receive funding from The American Ireland Fund. This is in the area of fundraising and Board development. The Ireland Funds in Dublin work with approximately 6 - 10 organizations per month to provide this educational service. In 2009, they distributed the Philanthropy Toolkit to over 150 organizations and hosted a seminar on fundraising for 200 CEO’s, Board Directors and fundraisers from nonprofit organizations throughout Ireland. They also collaborated on two key pieces of research in this sector: baseline research to measure the level of fundraising in Ireland and broad research to evaluate fundraising activities in other countries that could be developed in Ireland. Both pieces of research were published and distributed to the sector in 2009. Additionally, as part of ongoing research, they collaborate with a number of other foundations to share research, identify emerging needs and evaluate grants. These “affinity groups” meet in the areas of disadvantaged youth, mental health, and peace and reconciliation programs. Finally, they regularly visit organizations throughout the country and evaluate their progress in developing and implementing a comprehensive strategy for each organization to enhance and ensure ongoing effectiveness in meeting its program goals.
