Below is a detailed explanation of the program, outlining the criteria for qualification. Please follow all the instructions to complete the application, either on-line or by mail. **There is additional information required to complete your application packet. It is your responsibility to request these materials.** Deadline for receipt of all applications and additional back up materials is **February 15**. The Center for Scholarship Administration, Inc. (CSA), an independent, non-profit scholarship administration service, is the administrator of the program for Wachovia Bank, N.A., Trustee of the scholarship fund.

APPLICANT CRITERIA

The selections will be based on provisions and limitations provided in the Trust Agreement as follows:

- ☛ Applicants may be high school seniors, undergraduate or graduate students. Preference will be given to students attending Salem Academy in Winston Salem, NC.
- ☛ Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 through the latest fall term.
- ☛ Applicants must demonstrate worthiness and character.
- ☛ Applicants must be planning to attend or are currently enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university in North Carolina. Preference will be given to students attending Randolph Macon College, High Point College, Guilford College or Salem College.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of academic achievement and potential to succeed in the student's chosen educational field. This is a competitive scholarship program. Selections are based on information received from the application and the additional requested materials postmarked no later than February 15.

Additional materials required in order to complete an application include:

- ☛ Official transcript with grades, cumulative GPA, class rank and SAT/ACT scores through the latest fall term for high school seniors. Students already enrolled in college must submit an official transcript with grades and cumulative GPA posted through the latest fall term.
- ☛ Letter of recommendation from teacher/professor.
- ☛ Essay

No employee or family member of Wachovia Bank, CSA staff, or the Selection Committee shall be eligible to receive scholarship awards.

Scholarships shall be awarded on an objective and non-discriminatory basis, with neither race, creed, color, sex, age, nor disability being considered.

The amount of the scholarship will be based upon the market value of the scholarship funds assets each year and determined by the Trustee. The award will be applied to the cost of tuition, fees and books. The award amount will be divided equally between semesters/quarters. Checks will be issued directly to the college upon receipt of the required information. Checks will not be issued without a copy of the recipient's transcript with grades and a cumulative GPA posted through the last semester. CSA will contact the colleges to have enrollment certified. In the event the college does not certify enrollment it will be the responsibility of the student to provide CSA with a copy of their bill. All information must contain the name of the college, the student's name, address and social security number. Unused funds will be returned to the Taylor M. Simpson and Evelyn W.
