TO CONDUCT SUCH PROGRAMS IN THE FIELD OF EDUCATION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, INFORMATION GATHERING ON LIBERAL ARTS AND SCIENCES EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND TO SERVE AS A CLEARING-HOUSE FOR DATA ON ACADEMIC CURRICULA AND BEST PRACTICES IN THE FIELD OF EDUCATION.
