Primary Exempt purpose:

Our organization has designed and developed one (1) program in furtherance of our purposes

Charlotte Knights Fundraising

Ovations Food Service and the Charlotte Knights' management team offer local nonprofit organizations the chance to operate the concession stands as a fund-raising opportunity. All participating organizations are guaranteed to raise a specific dollar amount. Each group must provide at least 10 people to work the stand, supported by up to two experienced Ovations team managers and an Ovations runner who provides legwork. Ovations offers a percentage of net revenues to each group that volunteers at each game Permanent locations in the stadium offer a higher percentage of net revenues Ovations offers as many as 72 games (entire season) or as few as 20 games. The higher the commitment, the better the revenue generating location or concession stand offered.

This fundraising activity is conducted by members of SDS Parent Boosters Inc. on a volunteer basis. This activity takes place during late spring and early summer,

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coinciding with the Charlotte Knights baseball season and takes place at the Charlotte Knights Stadium located in Fort Mill, SC. For 2009, SDS Parent Boosters are working games from April 1, 2009 through August 31, 2009. This represents approximately 40% of our total activity time for 2009. On average, we work 6 hours per event. We have signed up for 28 games in 2009 and average 7 volunteers per game. This represents 1176 man hours of volunteer time for the spring and summer. There is no external funding required to support this activity, outside of some incidental costs related to printing, copying, and distribution of the information to the parents of competitive dancers

This fundraising activity directly supports our exempt purpose. We have the ability to further the sport of competitive dance by raising money that is used to offset the cost of regional and national competitions.

Line 29:

Carolina Panthers Fundraising

Stadium Food and Beverage, the official provider of food, beverage and merchandise for the Carolina Panthers at Bank of America Stadium, partners with non-profit organizations by giving them the chance to increase their fundraising income while working in a fun and exciting environment

Non-profit and civic organizations such can raise money for their groups by working events at Bank of America Stadium. Organizations that can bring 25-40 volunteers per event are staffed in concession stands and as vendors in the stadium bowl. Groups must commit to staffing a specific location at every Panthers home game, as well as any college football games and other stadium-wide events.

This fundraising activity is conducted by members of SDS Parent Boosters Inc. on a volunteer basis. This activity takes place during late summer and fall, coinciding with the Carolina Panthers football season and takes place at the Bank of America Stadium located in Charlotte, NC. For 2009, SDS Parent Boosters are working games from August 9, 2009 through December 31, 2009. This represents approximately 60% of our total activity time for 2008. On average, we work 9 hours per event. We have signed up for 12 games in 2008 and average 16 volunteers per game. This represents 1728 man hours of volunteer time for the summer and fall. There is no external funding required to support this activity, outside of some incidental costs related to printing, copying, and distribution of the information to the parents of competitive dancers.

This fundraising activity directly supports our exempt purpose by raising money that is used to offset the cost of regional and national competitions.
