In December, FAST brought together 94 parents/caregivers to hear about the latest research on AS, the goals and objectives of FAST, its progress towards meeting those goals and its plans for the future. Speakers included the head of FAST's Scientific Advisory Board, Dr. Edwin Weeber, who cured AS in the mouse model. In addition, networking/mentoring opportunities were facilitated so that people caring for individuals of the same age or with similar circumstances could exchange experiences, information and guidance and solidify relationships.

speech impairment. A few individuals with AS develop functional speech, but most communicate through a mixture of gestures, eye gaze, adapted sign language and augmentative communication devices. Individuals with AS have developmental delay and intellectual disabilities. Current research suggests that neuronal development occurs correctly in the brain in AS, but neuronal functioning is impaired. This neuronal impairment impacts the individual's ability to learn in that skills are acquired less rapidly than in age-matched peers. However, AS individuals continue to progress throughout their lifespan, and their ability to learn is greatly enhanced by intensive educational programs, repetition, and environmental enrichment. The Foundation for Angelman Syndrome Therapeutics is an organization of families and professionals dedicated to finding a cure for AS and related disorders through the funding of an aggressive research agenda, education, advocacy, and community support. The Foundation is committed to assisting individuals living with AS to realize their full potential and quality of life.

Attachment 3 - Form 990, Part III, Line 2 - Program Services

As AS is a rare disorder, the community of parents and caregivers of individuals with AS rely heavily on social networking to become informed and seek advice and guidance on the challenges which the disorder presents. It is one of FAST's objectives to educate, support and strengthen this community. In December, FAST brought together 94 parents/caregivers to hear about the latest research on AS, the goals and objectives of FAST, its progress towards meeting those goals and its plans for the future. Speakers included the head of FAST's Scientific Advisory Board, Dr. Edwin Weeber, who cured AS in the mouse model. Networking/mentoring opportunities were facilitated so that people caring for individuals of the same age or with similar circumstances could exchange experiences, information and guidance and solidify relationships.
