#### Part III. Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

#### Portland Leadership Foundation's primary purposes include:

- 1 Developing educational and learning opportunities for students.
- 2. Creating joint initiatives or programs with other non-profits where needs are not being met
- 3. Promoting collaboration that yields results—across congregations, neighborhoods, businesses, philanthropists, and government agencies
- 4. Building the capacity of leaders and groups to serve the city of Portland

#### Line 28 - Building the Capacity of Leaders: Act Six Leadership and Scholarship Initiative

Act Six develops leaders through a simple, but powerful, four-step strategy:

- Recruit and select diverse, multicultural cadres of Portland's most promising emerging urban leaders. This year, Portland Leadership Foundation selected 21 scholars across the State of Oregon to attend Warner Pacific College and George Fox University of full-ride scholarships
- Train and prepare these groups of students in the year prior to college, equipping them to support each other, succeed academically, and grow as service-minded leaders and agents of transformation. After selecting the 21 scholars, we have been training them since January 2010.
- Send and fund the teams together to select faith-based colleges in Oregon on four year, full-tuition, full-need scholarships. In partnership with Warner Pacific College and George Fox University, this year we awarded \$2.3 million of scholarship funding (Portland Leadership Foundation does not fund the scholarships—the institutions do).
- Support and inspire by providing strong campus support and ongoing leadership development to
  nurture these young people as they find their vocation and grow into the next generation of
  community leaders. As we continue to grow the Act Six Initiative, it is important that we also
  improve in our effort to recruit students effectively. All together, we have 50 students in the Act
  Six Initiative that we currently support and inspire.

Accomplishments: \$2.5 million awarded in the last 12 months; 21 new scholars selected; 21 scholars trained once per week; mentoring of the current 51 scholars monthly; relationship development with staff, faculty, and administration of partner colleges.

# Line 29 - Promoting Collaboration: Young Family Foundation/Warner Pacific College Consulting and Collaboration: Portland Leadership Foundation is focused on helping local nonprofits take their good intentions and produce more effective outcomes through collaboration. This last year, we have consulted with the Young Family Foundation and Warner Pacific College as both organizations are in the midst of transition.

Young Family Foundation: The Young family is working to develop a home for transient or homeless boys in Southeast Portland. We have been helping them think through the development of their foundation including: brand development, budget development, vision casting, strategic planning, and operationalizing the vision.

<u>Accomplishments</u>: We have met with the Young Family Foundation staff over 10 times to develop the above variables. The outcomes have developed and resulted in a current operational foundation.

Warner Pacific College: Portland Leadership Foundation currently consults Warner Pacific College by helping the President develop a new strategic plan for redeveloping the college's identity. Our role is focused on collaborating with current staff and faculty through a Presidential Commission—to help the college reach out to the City of Portland through the development of an "Urban Plan."

<u>Accomplishments:</u> We meet at least twice per week with the President of Warner Pacific and at least once every three weeks with the appointed Urban Commission. The result has been the development of a 42-page "Urban Plan" detailing the future goals of the transformation of Warner Pacific College.

## Line 30 - Creating joint initiatives or programs with other non-profits: The Retention Project (with Oregon Campus Compact)

The Retention Project: Portland Leadership Foundation has partnered with Oregon Campus Compact to develop a new initiative called, "The Retention Project." The Retention Project is a multi-institution mentoring collaborative designed around recruiting 1,000 new mentors in the Portland metro area by 2013. The project is spearheaded with our key partner, Oregon Campus Compact (OCC). OCC recently won a \$860k grant through AmeriCorps to place 30 employees in higher education institutions over the next three years to recruit college students as mentors. We are currently solidifying our college partners and hiring our first batch of staff to embed in each partner institution.

Accomplishments: The Retention Project has taken six months to develop. Having identified Oregon Campus Compact as a executive partner, we then began networking with the local college President's to develop a logic model that describes our intention of creating a delivery system to connect college students with mentoring opportunities in the State of Oregon. We have identified 9 of the 10 partner institutions. We are currently developing a brand for the Retention project and networking to hire 10 new staff through the awarded AmeriCorps grant at Oregon Campus Compact. We have also written two grants to the Department of Justice. The Retention Project will be rolled-out in September.
