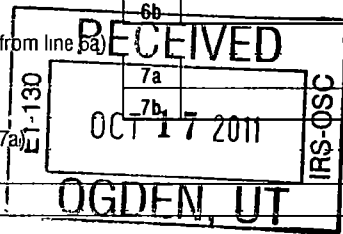

TUCSON VALUES TEACHERS (TVT) IS AN INNOVATIVE PARTNERSHIP AMONG THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY, EDUCATORS AND THE PUBLIC IN PIMA COUNTY DEDICATED TO TRANSFORMING THE WAYS IN WHICH TEACHERS ARE VALUED AS A MEANS OF IMPROVING THE K-12 EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM IN PIMA COUNTY. LAUNCHED ON OCTOBER 1, 2008, THE INITIATIVE HAS BEEN GROWING STRONG THANKS TO THE COMMITMENT OF ALL AREA SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS, THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA AND A WIDE RANGE OF COMMITTED BUSINESS PARTNERS.

2009 PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

**PUBLIC RELATIONS:** CALIBER COMMUNICATIONS COMPLETED A PHASE 2 MEDIA CAMPAIGN THAT HAS INCLUDED A REVISED BROCHURE, BUMPER STICKERS AND OTHER BACKUP MATERIAL. A FULL-BLOWN ADVERTISING CAMPAIGN HAS ALSO BEEN DESIGNED WITH PRIMARY ACTION: JOIN TEAM TVT. THE FIRM ALSO HELPED GUIDE THE HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL MAY 19 LAUNCH OF SUMMER BREAKS FOR TEACHERS (DETAILS BELOW UNDER INCENTIVES). THE HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL MEDIA COVERAGE INCLUDED AN INTERVIEW ON ARIZONA PUBLIC MEDIA'S ARIZONA ILLUSTRATED, AN EDITORIAL BY SUPERINTENDENT DOUG WILSON ON ARIZONA ILLUSTRATED, DAYLONG STORIES ON KGUN AND KVOA, A FEATURE STORY AND EDITORIAL IN THE ARIZONA STAR AND COVERAGE IN THE EXPLORER AND NUMEROUS OTHER REGIONAL PUBLICATIONS. MEDIA PARTNERS FOR TVT INCLUDE THE ARIZONA STAR, ARIZONA PUBLIC MEDIA, CLEAR CHANNEL, COX MEDIA AND LOCAL BROADCAST STATIONS.

**INDUSTRY INTERNSHIPS:** TWENTY TEACHERS HAVE BEEN PLACED IN INTERNSHIPS IN LOCAL BUSINESSES AND FIRST DAY OF WORK FOR MOST IS JUNE 1. TUCSON VALUES TEACHERS MET THE \$250,000 MATCHING REQUIREMENT FOR A GRANT FROM SCIENCE FOUNDATION ARIZONA. RAYTHEON, SEBRA, GENERAL PLASMA, BEACH FLEISCHMAN, UA BIOSPHERE 2 AND SUNDT STEPPED UP TO CREATE THE INTERNSHIPS AND ALL ARE PAYING INDUSTRY WAGES TO THE TEACHERS. THE GRANT ALSO COVERS THE FULL TIME SALARY OF JULIA OLSEN, WHO IS LEADING THE PROGRAM FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA, IN COLLABORATION WITH TUCSON VALUES TEACHERS. INTERNSHIPS RUN FOR 8-10 WEEKS THIS SUMMER. THE PROGRAM IS PLANNED FOR THREE YEARS.

**INCENTIVES:** SUMMER BREAKS FOR TEACHERS DISCOUNT CARD WERE SUCCESSFULLY DISTRIBUTED TO 10,000 PUBLIC, PRIVATE AND CHARTER SCHOOL TEACHERS THROUGHOUT SOUTHERN ARIZONA ON MAY 19. THE WILDLY SUCCESSFUL DISTRIBUTION HAS BEEN VERY POSITIVELY RECEIVED BY K-12 TEACHERS AND WIDELY EMBRACED BY THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY. JIM CLICK OF JIM CLICK AUTOMOTIVE UNDERWROTE THE ACTUAL COST OF THE CARD AND ALSO CREATED A GENEROUS BENEFIT PACKAGE FOR TEACHERS. OTHER BUSINESSES PROVIDING A RANGE OF DISCOUNTS FOR TEACHERS THAT REMAIN IN EFFECT THROUGH LABOR DAY INCLUDE LOEWS VENTANA RESORT, LIVE THE SOLUTION, TREASURES 4 TEACHERS, CUP CAFE, MAYNARDS MARKET AND KITCHEN, MAGPIES GOURMET PIZZA, YMCA OF SOUTHERN ARIZONA, OLD PUEBLO GRILL, METROPOLITAN GRILL, MCMAHON'S, GRILL ON THE GREEN AT CANOA RANCH, TORRES BLANCAS GOLF CLUB, CONOA RANCH GOLF CLUB, VISCOUNT SUITES, EL CHARRO CAFE, U-STOR SELF STORAGE.

A PRESS CONFERENCE WAS ALSO HELD ON MAY 19 TO ANNOUNCE THE LAUNCH AND SPECIAL SPEAKERS INCLUDED MAYOR ROBERT WALKUP, JIM CLICK, AMPHI SUPERINTENDENT VICKI BALENTINE, PRINCE ELEMENTARY PRINCIPAL (WHERE THE EVENT WAS HELD) TASSI CALL AND TVT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR JACQUELYN JACKSON. SPECIAL TVT T-SHIRTS WERE DESIGNED AND DISTRIBUTED TO TWO OF THE CLASSES WHO MADE A SPECIAL PRESENTATION OF THANKS TO TEACHERS AND TO THE BUSINESSES.

A SURVEY WAS SENT TO K-12 PUBLIC, PRIVATE AND CHARTER SCHOOL TEACHERS TO DETERMINE WHAT THEY CONSIDER THE MOST BENEFICIAL DISCOUNTS. MORE THAN 500 TEACHERS RESPONDED AND THE INCENTIVES THAT ARE PROVIDED ON THE CARD ARE A DIRECT RESPONSE TO WHAT THEY SAID THEY NEEDED MOST - CLASSROOM SUPPLIES, HOUSING AND AUTOMOTIVE ASSISTANCE, RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND BEING ABLE TO EAT OUT. THE TUCSON HISPANIC CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, THE PIMA COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT'S OFFICE WERE KEY PARTNERS IN THE CARD DEVELOPMENT AND DISTRIBUTION.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT: THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA IS LEADING EFFORTS TO EXPAND AND PUBLICIZE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN THE REGION. PARTNERS INCLUDE PIMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE, THE UNIVERSITY OF PHOENIX AND THE PIMA COUNTY REGIONAL SUPPORT CENTER.

EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES: VOICES FOR EDUCATION COMMISSIONED RESEARCH TO DETERMINE THE BEST STEPS TO TAKE TO SECURE A BALLOT INITIATIVE IN 4 -5 YEARS THAT WOULD CREATE A REVENUE STREAM FOR TEACHERS SALARIES THAT COULD BOOST BY \$10,000 THE SALARY LEVELS FOR TEACHERS. RESEARCH IS BEING ANALYZED TO DETERMINE THE BEST NEXT STEPS. IN ADDITION, ALL MEDIA AND PUBLICITY IS BEING STRUCTURED TO BEGIN TO CHANGE THE WAYS IN WHICH TEACHERS ARE VALUED WITH THE END GOAL OF GAINING THEIR APPROVAL FOR WHEN THE INITIATIVE IS ON THE BALLOT.

METRICS: TUCSON VALUES TEACHERS IS WORKING CLOSELY WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA TO DEVELOP MEANINGFUL MEASUREMENTS OF EACH OF THE TVT STRANDS. THESE WILL BE USED TO MEASURE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PROGRAM AND DETERMINE ITS IMPACT ON IMPROVING K-12 EDUCATION IN THE REGION.
