ARTHUR R. PASKOFF & DORIS PASKOFF CHARITABLE FOUNDATION

- 1a. Educational grants will be made for study at Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii) educational institutions and for study programs not necessarily leading to a degree, such as an in depth study of a particular subject. The focus of the scholarships would be to study the fields of health, education and the public welfare.
- lb. Educational grants will be to enable students to attend college and engage in independent study.
 - 1c. Educational loans are not contemplated.
- 1d. The Scholarship Program is not yet operational. It is anticipated that the Scholarship Program will be publicized by word of mouth.
 - 1e. There are no ancillary materials as of yet.
- 1f. The Scholarship Program anticipated to be followed by the Foundation is attached. The attached Scholarship Program details the mechanics of the program that will be implemented. The Student Application Checklist is part of that Program.
- 3. See Section 3 of the Scholarship Program (page 2 of the attached). That section describes eligible students.
- 4a. Selection process is described in Section 4 of the Scholarship Program (page 3 of the attached).
- 4b. The number of grants will be based on available funds as determined by the Directors and grant requests.
- 4c. The amount of each grant will be based on the needs of the particular applicant and available funds.

- 4d. There are no requirements or conditions.
- 5. Section 5 of the Scholarship Program (page 6 of the attached) describes grant supervision.
- 6. Arthur and Doris Paskoff, the Directors of the Organization, will comprise the initial Selection Committee, which is further described in Section 4.3 of the Scholarship Program (page 4 of the attached). Again, the Scholarship Program is not operational and, thus, there are no current members.

ARTHUR R. PASKOFF & DORIS PASKOFF CHARITABLE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- 1. <u>Statement of Purpose</u>. The Organization hereby establishes a program (the "Program") for the granting of scholarships and fellowships to individuals pursuing undergraduate, graduate independent study and/or post-graduate education. Pursuant to the Program, the Organization may, from time to time:
- 1.1 Award scholarships or fellowships to be used for study at an educational organization described in Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii) of the Code and scholarships to individuals who want to study the areas of health, education and Public Welfare. The particular fields of study are Education, Nursing, Medicine, Social Work, Psychology, and Sociology.
- 1.2 The Selection Committee (as defined herein) will (i) develop scholarship criteria and scholarship outreach and application materials; and (ii) review scholarship applications and make scholarship award determinations. See 4.3 below.

Any provision contained herein which is inconsistent with the foregoing intentions shall be deemed null, void and inoperative.

2. Grants. The Organization may award Scholarships (as defined herein) each academic year ("Year") to Eligible Students for study at a Qualified Institution. The Organization may also award Stipends (as defined herein) at any time and from time to time to Eligible Recipients for the purposes set forth in Section 1.2 herein. The number, amount and categories of Scholarships and Stipends shall be based on the determination of Directors each Year, pursuant to Section 4 hereof. Scholarships and Stipends awarded pursuant to the Program shall collectively be known as "Grants."

3. **Definitions.**

- 3.1 <u>Eligible Student</u>. The term "Eligible Student" shall mean an individual who satisfies all of the following requirements:
- (a) The individual is currently a high school senior, an undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited junior college, college or university, or a graduate student, or other person pursuing a graduate or post-graduate degree, who has been accepted to attend a Qualified Institution for the following Year;
- (b) The individual is neither an employee of the Qualified Institution, nor is related to an employee of the Qualified Institution; and
- (c) The individual is neither a relative or employee of a member of the Organization or any other "disqualified person" as defined with respect to private foundations.
- 3.2 <u>Eligible Recipient</u>. The term "Eligible Recipient" shall mean a person who has a literary, artistic, musical, scientific, teaching or other similar skill or talent, and is seeking a grant for purposes of achieving a specific objective, produce a report or other similar product, or is otherwise seeking to improve or enhance such skill or talent.
 - 3.3 <u>Scholarship.</u> The term "Scholarship" shall mean either:
- (a) A "Qualified Scholarship" as defined in Section 117(b) of the Code that is granted to an Eligible Student to cover all or part of the following expenses of his or her course of study as a student at a Qualified Institution:
- (i) Tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance at a Qualified Institution; and/or
- (ii) Fees, books, supplies and equipment required for such individual's course of study at the Qualified Institution; or

- (b) Amounts which would qualify as a scholarship or fellowship grant pursuant to the provisions of Section 117(a) of the Code as in effect on the day before the date of the enactment of the Tax Reform Act of 1986, including:
- (i) Amounts received as a scholarship at a Qualified Institution, including the value of contributed services and accommodations;
- (ii) Any amount received as a fellowship, including the value of contributed services and accommodations; and/or
- (ii) Any amount received to cover expenses for travel, research, clerical help or equipment which are incident to such scholarship or fellowship, but only to the extent that the amount is so expended by the Eligible Student.
- 3.4 <u>Stipend.</u> The term "Stipend" shall mean a grant awarded for purposes of achieving a specific objective, producing a report or other similar product, or otherwise improving or enhancing a literary, artistic, musical, scientific, teaching or other similar capacity, skill or talent of an Eligible Recipient.
- 3.5 Qualified Institution. The term "Qualified Institution" shall mean a college, university or other graduate educational institution that is described in Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii) of the Code.

4. Selection Process.

- 4.1 <u>Determination of Grants to be Awarded.</u> Each Year, the Organization shall determine the amount of funds that will be made available to the Program, and the number, amount and categories of Grants to be granted under the Program for that Year.
- 4.2 <u>Categories of Scholarships</u>. The categories of Scholarships may include; without limitation, any one or more than one of the following:
 - (a) Scholarships to students engaged in a specified field of study or

who are candidates for a specified degree;

- (b) Scholarships to students residing in a specific geographic area; and/or
- (c) Scholarships to students for study at a particular educational institution.

4.3 <u>Selection Committee.</u>

- (a) The Grant recipients shall be chosen by the Directors of the Organization, which may seek the assistance of one or more "Qualified Persons" (the "Selection Committee"). A "Qualified Person" shall mean (i) a person knowledgeable in the educational field (such as educators, school administration officials or guidance counselors); (ii) a person having expertise or knowledge in the areas of health, education and public welfare with knowledge of particular courses, fields of study, or degrees in those areas for which a Grant may be awarded (such as an educator, writer or researcher in that particular field); (iii) a person having a connection to the specific geographic area in which Eligible Students reside (such as a community leader); and/or (iv) a person having a connection to the educational institution where Eligible Students will study (such as a member of the faculty or administration of such institution, or an alumnus).
- (b) Notwithstanding the above, no person shall assist the Selection Committee if such person will be in a position to derive a private benefit, directly or indirectly, if certain potential grantees are selected over others.
- (c) All Grant recipients shall be chosen by the Selection Committee on an objective and non-discriminating basis.
- 4.4 <u>Notice of Grant Availability.</u> The Organization shall make the availability of the Program known by oral or written communications and/or publication

designed to (a) reach a group of Eligible Students and Eligible Recipients to be chosen on the basis of criteria reasonably related to the category or categories of Grants to be awarded in that Year; and (b) establish a group of Eligible Students or Eligible Recipients sufficiently large to constitute a charitable class within the meaning of Treasury Regulation Section 53.4945-4(b)(2).

4.5 <u>Application Process.</u> The Selection Committee shall establish an application process which shall require each Eligible Student or Eligible Recipient who is interested in receiving a Grant under the Program to (a) submit a written application in a form or forms prepared or approved by the Selection Committee; (b) submit to a personal interview with the Selection Committee; or (c) comply with any other rules and regulations which the Selection Committee considers necessary or appropriate to carry out its duties hereunder. In the case of a Scholarship, the written application may consist, in whole or in part, of the financial aid form used by the Qualified Institution.

4.6 Objective Basis for Selection.

- (a) The Selection Committee shall give consideration to all Eligible Students and Eligible Recipients who apply for a Grant under the Program.
- (b) In considering the Scholarship applications submitted to it, the Selection Committee shall be guided by objective criteria related to the ability of each Eligible Student to successfully complete his or her course of study at the Qualified Institution. Proper criteria shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
 - (i) Prior academic performance;
- (ii) Performance on tests designed to measure ability and aptitude for undergraduate, graduate and/or post-graduate studies;
 - (iii) Recommendations from instructors and references from

persons not related to the Eligible Student;

- (iv) Financial need; or
- (v) The conclusions which the Selection Committee may draw from a personal interview as to the Eligible Student's character, motivation, ability and potential.
- (c) In any case in which none of the above criteria are available to the Selection Committee, the Selection Committee shall make its decision on the basis of the information reasonably available to it and on the basis of such other information which the Selection Committee believes in good faith is material to an objective and non-discriminatory selection process.

4.7 Award of Grants.

- (a) The Selection Committee shall determine the Eligible Students and Eligible Recipients for whom the Organization will make a Grant ("Grantee").
- (b) The Selection Committee shall notify each Grantee in writing of the scholarship grant.
- 4.8 <u>Scholarship Payments</u>. To the extent possible, the Organization shall pay the Scholarship directly to each Qualified Institution, provided that the Qualified Institution agrees to use such funds to defray each Grantee's expenses permitted pursuant to Section 3.3 herein, so long as such Grantee is enrolled at the Qualified Institution as a student in good standing.

5. Supervision of Grants

5.1 Reports.

(a) The Organization shall make arrangements with each Qualified Institution to receive directly from such Qualified Institution annual reports of the Grantee's courses taken and grades received in each academic period.

- (b) In any case where a Grantee's study does not involve the taking of courses, but only the preparation of research papers or projects, the Organization shall make arrangements with such Qualified Institution to receive annual reports on the progress of the paper or project, which reports must be approved by the faculty member supervising the Grantee, or by another appropriate official at such Qualified Institution.
- (c) In the case of a Stipend, the Organization shall require annual reports on the use of the funds and the progress made by the Grantee toward achieving the purposes for which the Stipend was made. Upon completion of the undertaking for which the Stipend was made, the Organization shall make arrangements to receive a final report describing the Grantee's accomplishments with respect to the Stipend and an accounting for the funds received under the Stipend.
- 5.2 <u>Procedure for Continuation of Grants.</u> Grants may be continued unless the Organization receives information indicating that the original grant is being used for a purpose other than that for which it was made, or the Organization has not received any reports due from a Grantee. Any additional criteria and the procedures used for continuation of a Grant shall be objective and non-discriminatory. Scholarships may be continued only to Grantees who have and maintain good standing at their respective Qualified Institutions.
- 5.3 <u>Investigation of Jeopardized Grants.</u> In any case where the Organization has paid all or any part of a Grant directly to the Grantee, and the reports submitted to the Organization indicate that all or any part of such Grant is not being used in furtherance of the purposes of such Grant, or if the Qualified Institution or Grantee fails to issue such reports:
- (a) The Organization shall investigate the circumstances surrounding the use of the grant funds.

- (b) During the investigation, the Organization shall withhold all further payments to the Grantee to the extent possible.
- 5.4 <u>Recovery of Grants</u>. In any case in which the Organization concludes that a Grant has been used for improper purposes:
- (a) The Organization shall take all reasonable and appropriate steps to recover the grant funds. Such reasonable steps shall include legal action, unless the Organization, in their discretion, concludes that such action would not result in the satisfaction of execution on a judgment.
- (b) The Organization shall withhold any further payments to the Grantee unless: (i) such Grantee has granted the Organization his or her assurance that future improper uses of such funds will not occur; and (ii) the Organization requires the Grantee to take extraordinary precautions to prevent future diversions from occurring.
- (c) In any case in which a Grantee repeatedly diverts grant funds for an improper purpose, the Organization shall withhold all further payments to the Grantee until such diverted funds are in fact recovered and the requirements of Section 5.4(b) herein are met.
- 5.5 <u>Retention of Records</u>. The Organization shall maintain formal, written records concerning the selection of Grantees. Such records shall include, among other things which the Organization deems material:
- (a) all information the Organization secured to evaluate the qualifications of particular Grantees;
 - (b) identification of each Grantee;
- (c) specification of the amount and purpose of each Grant granted hereunder; and

(d) all follow-up information which the Organization receives in compliance with this Section 5.

Pasekoff Foundation Request for Funding

This form is used by the Arthur R. Pasekoff & Doris Pasekoff Charitable Foundation (the "Pasekoff Foundation") to accept requests for funding of events and activities that may qualify as a charitable or educational purpose as defined by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, (the "Code") and regulations and other rulings of the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS"). This document contains instructions for completing the request forms.

The request form is two pages. The first page is a Pre-Approval and is submitted prior to the event, activity, or incurred expense. The Pre-Approval step provides an opportunity for the Directors of the Pasekoff Foundation (the "Selection Committee") to clarify allowed and disallowed qualifying expenses and activities and will help to prevent situations where a requesting group is less likely to incur an expense and then find out that the expense does not meet the IRS definition of a charitable purpose. The second page is used after the event(s) have taken place. When a Pre-Approval is submitted and approved by the Selection Committee, the amount and use of the funds requested is consistent with the approval, then the Treasurer is generally authorized to disburse the funds immediately upon submission of the second page. However, the Treasurer shall refer final approval to the Selection Committee at their discretion.

Items on the Pre-Approval Page

The pre-approval page contains information necessary to identify the person(s) requesting the funds, and the anticipated use of the funds. Include the exact or estimated amount of support requested and if any amount is required in advance. The Selection Committee may authorize up to 100% of the funds requested to be provided in advance.

Description of tax-exempt charitable purpose

Code § 501(c)(3) defines qualified charitable use purposes as one or more of the following: charitable, educational, religious, scientific, literary, fostering national or international sports competition, prevention of cruelty to children or animals, or testing for public safety. Generally, the Pasekoff Foundation operations cover health, educational and public welfare related charitable purposes as defined further by the IRS. The Pasekoff Foundation cannot authorize the use of funds for political purposes such as campaigns or lobbying.

Charitable purposes approved for the Pasekoff Foundation include support for individuals who demonstrate a specific and serious need for support to maintain the health, safety and general well being of themselves and their families. Other approved purposes include donations and support to other Code § 501(c)(3) entities.

Description of the documentation to be provided

Adequate documentation is imperative to ensure that the Pasekoff Foundation can prove compliance with all appropriate IRS regulations. The form asks the submitter to provide a description of the documentation anticipated to be received after use of the funds requested, for example, a receipt or invoice from the provider of any food, goods, services that may be needed, i.e. a purchase order with line items clearly identifying each item and amount, or a hotel room receipt. Generally speaking a non-itemized credit card receipt or non-detailed receipt (such as an adding machine tape) are **NOT** sufficient documentation and must be supported by additional

documentation that clearly and unambiguously identifies the beneficiaries, the expense, and the purpose.

Items on the Disbursement Request Page

The disbursement request page is submitted after the expenses are incurred. Please attach a copy of any prior approved pre-approval form with the disbursement request.

Description of results

Please include a summary of the results that were achieved. This can be short, however, it should adequately demonstrate how the participants benefited and the results realized by the event or activity or overall use of the funds received.

Documentation

Finally, summarize all attached expense documentation attached to the form, for example, the receipts and letters included.
