The costs of these measures are reported in this 2009 Annual Report (IRS Form 990). The financial benefits which are expected to be realized from measures should occur over the next several years. An Early Retirement Incentive Plan (ERIP) was offered to certain employees of The Ohio Masonic Home, The Ohio Masonic Home Benevolent Foundation and Springfield Masonic Community. The ERIP provided eligible employees with certain incentives to retire early. The retirement incentives included a pension buyout, severance options and temporary extension of health care benefits. The ERIP should enable the participating corporations to reduce their respective reoccurring operating cost. Other cost savings measures included a reduction in the skilled nursing bed capacity of Springfield Masonic Community (from 254 beds to 144 beds), a temporary wage freeze for all employees of the corporations who are covered by this 2009 Annual Report, a reduction in the employer contributions to the defined contribution plan, and the freezing of participation under the defined benefit plan
Schedule K	The Ohio Masonic Home, Masonic Financial Assistance Corporation, Springfield Masonic Community, The Browning Masonic Community, and Western Reserve Masonic Community are part of an obligated group for the series 2009 bond issue. The 2009 bonds were issued to finance the current refunding of prior bond issues and to acquire and construct additional care facilities for the Ohio Masonic Home and affiliated entities.
