Additionally, any board or board committee meeting where the subject of conflict of interest is discussed, the normally taken minutes shall contain the name of the party discussing a potential conflict of interest, the conflict of interest discussed, and whether a conflict of interest was found to exist. If a conflict of interest does exist, the member will be excused from participating in any discussion or voting on the particular agenda item.
