ARTICLES OF MERGER OF GATEWAY HEALTHCARE PROPERTIES, INC. AND CITY HOSPITAL FOUNDATION, INC.

Pursuant to Section 31E-11-1101, et. seq., of the West Virginia Nonprofit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporations hereby adopt the following Articles of Merger for the purpose of effecting a merger under the laws of the State of West Virginia:

- 1. Gateway Healthcare Properties, Inc., a West Virginia non-profit corporation ("GHP"), will merge with City Hospital Foundation, a West Virginia non-profit corporation ("CHF"), on the Effective Date, as defined below, and the separate existence of GHP will thereupon cease. CHF shall be the corporation that survives the Merger (the "Surviving Corporation in accordance with the applicable provisions of the West Virginia Nonprofit Corporation Act").
- 2. These Articles of Merger shall be delivered to the West Virginia Secretary of State for filing and shall take effect, pursuant to the West Virginia Nonprofit Corporation Act, upon the issuance by the West Virginia Secretary of State of a certificate of merger to the Surviving Corporation (the "Effective Date").
- 3. West Virginia University Hospitals, Inc., a West Virginia nonprofit corporation ("WVUH") is the ultimate parent corporation and sole member of West Virginia University Hospitals-East, Inc., a West Virginia nonprofit corporation ("WVUH-E"), being the sole member of GHP and of CHF.
- 4. WVUH holds certain reserved powers with respect to GHP and CHF including the authority to approve a merger or consolidation.
- 6. The Plan of Merger was duly approved by resolutions of the Board of Directors of WVUH in a manner required by the West Virginia Nonprofit Corporation Act and by the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of GHP.
- 7. The Plan of Merger was duly approved by resolutions of the Board of Directors of WVUH in a manner required by the West Virginia Nonprofit Corporation Act and by the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of CHF.
- 8. A copy of the Plan of Merger is attached hereto as Exhibit A and is incorporated herein.

PLAN OF MERGER BETWEEN GATEWAY HEALTHCARE PROPERTIES, INC. AND CITY HOSPITAL FOUNDATION, INC.

WHEREAS, the Constituent Corporations are subsidiary corporations of West Virginia University Hospitals-East, Inc., a West Virginia nonprofit corporation ("WVUH-E");

WHEREAS, WVUH-E is the sole corporate member of both GHP and CHF;

WHEREAS, WVUH-E and the Constituent Corporations share a common vision of serving the health care needs of the residents of the Eastern Panhandle of West Virginia;

WHEREAS, West Virginia University Hospitals, Inc., a West Virginia nonprofit corporation ("WVUH") is the sole member of WVUH-E and holds certain reserved powers with respect to the Constituent Corporations, including the authority to approve a merger or consolidation involving the Constituent Corporations;

WHEREAS, WVUH, WVUH-E and the Constituent Corporations believe that the merger of the Constituent Corporations will improve the health and well-being of the citizens of the Eastern Panhandle of West Virginia through the provision of more efficient, cost-effective healthcare services and related activities.

- NOW, THEREFORE, the Constituent Corporations, in consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements and provisions hereinafter contained, do hereby agree to merge on the terms and conditions herein provided, as follows:
- 1. The Merger. Upon the Effective Date (as defined below), GHP and CHF shall merge with CHF being the surviving corporation, and the separate corporate existence of GHP shall cease. All rights, privileges, immunities, powers, franchises and authority; all property, real and personal, tangible and intangible, of every kind and description, and all assets, including GHP's ownership interest in a physicians' office building, and all obligations and liabilities of GHP shall be taken by and deemed transferred to and vested in CHF by operation of law and without further act or deed and without reversion or impairment. The articles of incorporation and bylaws of CHF shall not be changed and the current slate of officers of CHF shall not be affected as a result of the merger described herein.
- 2. GHP Membership Interests. GHP is a membership organization. The membership interest of WVUH-E in GHP shall not be converted and shall terminate and cease to exist upon the Effective Date. The membership interest of WVUH-E in CHF, as the surviving corporation, shall remain in WVUH-E upon the Effective Date without change or amendment.

- 3. The Effective Date. The merger shall take effect (the "Effective Date") upon the issuance of the Secretary of State of West Virginia of a Certificate of Merger to CHF pursuant to Section 31E-11-1103 (b) of the Act and shall have the effect set forth in the West Virginia Nonprofit Corporation Act. CHF may, at any time after the Effective Date, take any action (including executing and delivering any document) in the name and on behalf of GHP in order to carry out and effectuate the transactions contemplated by this Plan.
- 4. Amendments. This Plan may not be amended prior to the filing of articles of merger except by WVUH and in accordance with the Act, the Articles and the Bylaws of the Constituent Corporations.

INTENDING TO BE BOUND, this Plan, having first been duly approved by resolutions of the Board of Directors of WVUH-E as the sole member of GHP and as the sole member of CHF and by WVUH as the sole member of WVUH-E, is hereby executed on behalf of each Constituent Corporation by their respective, duly authorized officers.
