### **Proposal Deadlines**

The Moriah Fund program board meets twice a year to consider proposals. Complete proposals must be received by March 1st to be considered for the spring grant cycle (May) and by August 1st to be considered for the fall grant cycle (November). If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, the proposal will be accepted the next business day. Proposals to the Israel Program must be submitted one month earlier, that is, February 1st for the spring grant cycle and July 10th for the fall grant cycle.


