As noted in Part III, Line 4b, the program's expenditures totaled \$309,568 for the year, consisting of \$309,568 in grants given. The foundation chose to operate GEAR UP as part of its mission to save additional operating costs of the program. If the foundation had created a separate organization to run the program, additional costs would have been incurred to administer the program (such as incorporation costs, filling fees, and professional service fees). These additional costs would have decreased the funds available to serve the intent of the program, specifically to aid the education of students within Muskingum County.
