Form 990, Part III, Line 4d - STUDENT NURSES LOAN FUND PROGRAM: The Trinity Health System School of Nursing Student Scholarship/Loan policy provides Trinity Health System School of Nursing students who are financially distressed, with scholarship/loan monies needed for tuition at a low rate of interest. Eligibility requirements include current enrollment in the Trinity Health System School of Nursing, a satisfactory level of academic achievement, current financial aid form on file, and the ability to document prior application for other types of financial assistance. FRANK AND BESSIE BLACKBURN SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Scholarship fund established to help young people from the Ohio Valley obtain a quality nursing education. NANCY BRIGHT PEDIATRIC EXCELLENCE PROGRAM: Scholarship fund established to provide a \$100 cash award to a Trinity Health System School of Nursing graduate who excels academically and clinically in the Pediatric Unit. The award is presented to one Trinity Health System School of Nursing student per graduating class. ROBERT D'ANNIBALLE SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Scholarship fund established for the Trinity Health System School of Nursing. The successful candidate selection is made by the School of Nursing Admissions Committee with the criteria being that the student is either a second or third year student and a resident of Jefferson County. CARMEL ESPOSITO COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP AWARD: Award given to a graduating senior nursing student from Trinity Health System School of Nursing who exhibited leadership qualities in the School of Nursing and throughout the local community. ROY KARMOSKY SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Scholarship fund established as a scholarship for the Trinity Health System School of Nursing and based upon academic quality and financial need of students. Additionally, the recipient must be a person with high moral and ethical character. MESAROS EMPLOYEE SUGGESTION PROGRAM: The Mesaros Employee Suggesion Program is designed to offer Trinity East and Trinity West employees the opportunity and incentive to submit their ideas for improvements in the operation of the hospital. Funds for the implementation of this program were given through a donation from Drs. Paul and Laura Mesaros. All full and part-time employees of Trinity East or Trinity West are eligible to participate in the program. The Trinity Health System Value Analysis Team reviews all suggestions and monetary awards are issued quarterly along with a runner-up award. Also, an annual award is presented representing the "best" suggestion among the four quarterly winners. PATRICK MACEDONIA AWARD: The Patrick Macedonia Excellence in Maternal and Newborn Nursing Award was established as an award to a graduating senior nursing student at the Trinity Health System School of Nursing. The successful candidate must be of high moral and ethical character and have demonstrated excellence in both academic and clinical maternal and newborn nursing. Graduates that plan to become employed within the Trinity Health System will be given first consideration for this award. NAYLOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM: The Naylor Scholarship Award Program provides a \$300 cash award to two nursing students (one junior and one senior student) to be used for direct educational expenses. The recipients must preferably be Jefferson County, Ohio residents and meet the stipulated criteria. The specific criteria includes high academic standing, and most importantly, show financial need. Also, expressing in a letter their need and view of their role as a Naylor Scholar. PAUL RUKSHA SCHOLARSHIP FUND: The Paul Ruksha Scholarship Fund was established to preferably help the residents of Jefferson County, Ohio, obtain a quality nursing education at Trinity Health System School of Nursing. Recipients must maintain a cumulative 2.75 grade point average. When this scholarship is included, along with the recipients other financial aid, it may not exceed the student's direct cost of tuition, room, board, books and student fees. The successful canditate must also meet all of the School's academic and ethical requirements. BARBARA JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND: The Barbara Johnson Scholarship Fund was established to be used as a scholarship fund for a needy person attending the Trinity Health System School of Nursing, under such terms and conditions as said Trinity shall set forth. All of the annual income shall be distributed to a high school graduate who will be enrolled full time in the Trinity School of Nursing. Said graduate must demonstrate a need for said bequest, must have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA and must have demonstrated a high quality of leadership and character.

Transfer of personal property, incurring or quaranteeing indebtedness or granting liens in excess of an amount prescribed from time to time by the Members. 5. Approval of Corporation or subsidiary trustees and directors based on agreed upon criteria. 6. Capital expenditures or grants in excess of an amount prescribed from tine to time by the Members. 7. Addition or termination of services. 8. Approval of selection of the slate of candidates for the office of CEO of the Corporation or any of its subsidiaries, provided, however, that a representative of each Member will serve on the selection committee. 9. Approval of the annual budget and strategic plan for the Corporation and its subsidiaries.

Upon the hearing or deliberation of any matter that comes before the Board of Trustees, the Board Chair or any individual member of the Board can raise a question related to any conflict that they may identify. The Board Chair in consultation with the CEO and the Full Board will make a determinitation on the question and the procedure to be followed in the individual case. The Board Chair, or his designee if the Chair is conflicted, will manage the conflict to assure an unbiased and objective discussion and decision.
Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15 - Process for Determining Compensation: Each Executive's compensation is reviewed and approved by the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees.
