The Steve Nash Foundation is a non-profit, U.S. 501(c)(3) private foundation (EIN 31-1753206) and a registered Canadian charity (BN 84815 4928 RR0001) founded by Steve and his family to assist underserved children in their health, personal development, education and enjoyment of life. While the Foundation accepts outside contributions and holds fundraising events, Steve continues to contribute generously to the Foundation's operations, and is a driving force behind the Foundation's public giving presence.

Each year, the Steve Nash Foundation offers grants to youth-focused organizations that foster development by addressing underlying conditions of poverty, medical need and restricted access to those resources that contribute to the well-being of children.
