THE TRUSTEES ARE MORE LIKELY TO LOOK WITH FAVOR UPON PROJECTS WHICH IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE; INCREASE THE RESPONSIVENESS OF AGENCIES TO COMMUNITY NEEDS; DEVELOPS SELF-RELIANCE; DIRECT THEMSELVES TO PREVENTION AS WELL AS TO TREATMENT; AND ELIMINATE DUPLICATION OF SERVICES AND ENCOURAGE COOPERATION.
