Mary's Kitchen

Our purpose is to provide food, clothing and basic services that support and enhance the quality of life for the hungry and the homeless.

We feed on average 75-85 hot meals per day and prepare a "bag lunch" for their dinner. Donated clothing and shoes are distributed daily, along with new socks, underwear and toiletries. Showers and laundry facilities are also provided.

Our goal is to continue Mary's legacy of providing for the homeless. Mary's Kitchen was founded on Christian principles, including compassion and respect for human dignity. Mary McAnena, affectionately called "the Mother Thereasa of Orange", began feeding the homeless in Hart Park in 1984. All morning long, she would prepare warm meals in her home on Grand Ave. and deliver them to her homeless friends in Hart Park. In 1994, with cooperation of the City of Orange, Mary's Kitchen was born on a city maintenance lot on Struck Avenue, next to the Orange Police Department. Mary past in December of 2003, a few months shy of her 101st birthday. Mary's Kitchen is a legal non profit corporation of California.

Our activities this year, have consisted of setting up the administrative functions, including a board of directors and committees which include operations, strategic planning and finance. Mary performed all of these functions herself and rarely asked for other opinions!! Mary's Kitchen is now positioned to raise funds to improve our facilities and services that we provide, including partnerships with other agencies to help get our clients off the streets.

Our clients consist of 85% male, 12% female and 3% children, most of which live along the Santa Ana River or in their vehicle. Mary's Kitchen is run solely by volunteers, approximately 50, and 89% of donations goes towards feeding the homeless. Turnip Rose Catering, Vons, Ralphs, Albertsons, and Whole Foods provide most of our food.
