We pay pharmacy bills directly to pharmacies. We pay gasoline stations so patients can pay for trips to hospitals to receive treatments. We pay up to \$300 per month total for medicines, gasoline, hospital treatments or prosthesis (wigs). No money is paid to cancer patients. We pay bills directly to providers to cover expenses not covered by insurance.
