Arline Landers deceased May 20, 2008 leaving her stock in Buckeye Steel and Plumbing Company (Buckeye) to the Richard and Arline Landers Foundation (Foundation). Buckeye began a plan of liquidation in 2008 that was completed as of March 31, 2011. During the liquidation Buckeye has made in excess of \$200,000 in charitable contributions. We are amending the 2009 Foundation 990-PF return to show the equity method of accounting for the Buckeye investment. The amended return shows the income and change on other comprehensive income of (\$282,928). We have also reduced the corresponding contribution from the estate that settled in 2009. We have increased the dividend income by \$900 based on income received after December 31, 2009, however recorded in 2009 by the investment company.
