Grants are made for a variety of purposes, and across a wide spectrum of fields, including arts and humanities, community and economic development, education, environment, health and social services, and youth services. Grant applications are thoroughly reviewed by a standing committee of the Board. The grants committee completes a conflict of interest statement for each funding cycle, and votes on all grants, with abstentions recorded. The committee makes a recommendation for funding to the full board twice yearly. The grants committee listens to presentations and makes site visits periodically for funded organizations as a part of their due diligence process, and all funded organizations are required to submit a signed grant agreement and final report at the conclusion of the grant period. Grant application materials and guidelines are available on the foundation's website, which also includes a listing of all funded grants. The foundation periodically hosts free educational workshops on grant writing, and supports a year-long grant writing assistance program through the Volunteer Center of Erie County.
O ther Information	Part IV	Grants to Individuals Policy for Scholarship Grants The Community Foundation has established Field of Interest Funds to provide grants for individuals for post secondary educational scholarships Scholarship applications are mailed to all graduating seniors in Eric County high schools and posted on the foundation's website. Additional applications are distributed to local colleges, libraries and high school guidance offices. Various committees review the scholarship applications. For Designated Funds, the non-profit organization which has established the fund, such as the College Women's Club, is responsible for selecting the student recipient. Designated Funds are appropriate when the scholarship is designated for one particular high school or for one particular service club, as examples. Field of Interest Funds are established for scholarships where the donor has specified that the scholarship may be awarded to students from more than one high school in the county or for students who may attend any U.S. college institution. For all Field of Interest scholarship funds, selection committees are appointed and approved by the Foundation's Board of Directors. Donors (and/or family or related persons to the donor) who have established the fund may serve on the committee, so long as they represent a minority of the committee membership. All committee members receive a copy of the Foundation's Conflict of Interest Policy, complete a disclosure statement annually, and abstain from voting on any scholarship recommendation where a conflict exists. It is the policy of the Community Foundation that no scholarships will be awarded to family members of the Foundation's staff, board, and donors who have established funds. Scholarship committees are given a set of criteria established in the fund agreement for each scholarship. They select a student recipient(s), and identify an alternate in the event that the recipient is unable to use the scholarship. Recipients are notified in writing of their scholarship award, and must si
