Broad Purposes:

Primarily local giving, with emphasis on education, child welfare, youth programs, mental health, social services, cultural programs, and environment and natural resources.

Grants are made for operating support, building funds, and special purposes, but ordinarily not for scientific and medical programs and research or in areas appropriately supported by the government and the Untied Way. The Trust has a policy not to entertain applications and appeals which readily generate broad public support, especially in the health area. Grants usually range in size from \$500 to \$10,000. NO GRANTS ARE.
