SEVERAL FIXED ASSETS WERE REMOVED FROM THE DEPRECIATION SCHEDULE DURING 2009 DUE TO A MASSIVE FIRE THAT DESTROYED MUCH OF THE ORGANIZATION'S FACILITIES AND ITS CONTENTS.

AS A RESULT OF THE FIRE, THE ORGANIZATION HAS RECEIVED OVER \$5,000,000 IN INSURANCE PROCEEDS. THE ENTIRE PORTION OF PROCEEDS IS GOING TO REBUILD THE FACILITIES.

ADDITIONALLY, \$84,000 OF DEBT WAS DISCHARGED TO THE ORGANIZATION AS A RESULT OF THE FIRE AND DEEMED TO BE AN INVOLUNTARY CONVERSION.
