THE ROYALTY PAYMENTS WERE FROM PREVIOUSLY ISSUED PUBLICATIONS, BOOK SERIES,
JOURNALS, LICENSING WITH LIBRARIES AND JSTOR PROGRAMS IN WHICH ASPA WAS NOT
EXPECTING ROYALTIES. THEREFORE, THEY WERE NOT CONSIDERED MISSING AS THEY
WERE NOT EXPECTED.

THE CHECKS TAKEN WERE DEPOSITED INTO A SEPARATE ACCOUNT THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAD SET UP AT THE STATE DEPARTMENT FCU. THE ACCOUNT WAS UNDER THE INDIVIDUAL'S NAME DOING BUSINESS AS ASPA.

ASPA HAS IMPLEMENTED TIGHTER CONTROLS BY SEGREGATING DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

AS WELL AS INSTITUTING ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES TO RECONCILE CASH RECEIPTS AND

ACTIVITY POSTED TO THE MEMBER DATABASE ON A DAILY BASIS. THE PROCEDURES

ARE PERFORMED PRIOR TO RECORDING THE RELATED INCOME IN THE ACOUNTING
