Ranges for the Executive Director and key employees are shared with the Executive Committee to provide the necessary framework to make compensation decisions. The Executive Committee also receives comparative compensation data for CEO/Executive Director and all other relevant positions that has been compiled by the American Society of Association Executives (national data), and their local chapter, the Association Forum of Chicago. Formal meeting minutes of the Executive Committee's deliberations are compiled and filed.
