

The magazine also focuses on current issues relating to poetry in the culture, as well as presenting critical exchanges, debates, reviews, and special features. The magazine receives and reads over 90,000 submissions of poetry a year and publishes 11 issues a year. Circulation was over 25,000 in December 2009. In addition to the print edition, the magazine is now available online and its editors offer frequent podcasts in conjunction with each new issue.

This exciting new program, which began in 2005, helps students master public speaking skills, build self-confidence, and learn about their literary heritage. The 2008/2009 program included nearly 300,000 students from across the country, up from about 250,000 over the prior year. The Foundation also offers programs through the media that reached a total audience of over 16 million in 2009. These programs include television, radio and new spaper. In addition, the Foundation presents staged readings, lectures and performances of poetry with audience attendance increasing 8% over the prior year to over nearly 5,000. The Foundation also fully implemented its poetry institute program in 2009 which studied the impact of new media on poetry and prepared a report which included best practices and guides for poets dealing with intellectual property issues.
