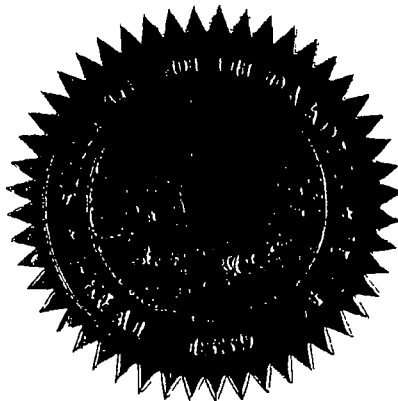

**Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of
Aberdeen Area Community Foundation, Inc.**

The following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of Aberdeen Area Community Foundation, Inc. correctly set forth the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as heretofore amended. There being no members of the corporation, these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were duly adopted as required by law in that they were unanimously adopted by the Board of Trustees on September 1, 2009 pursuant to a Writing in Lieu of Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Aberdeen Area Foundation, Inc., which Writing in Lieu of Meeting was executed by each of the duly appointed trustees. These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments to said original Articles of Incorporation.

**Article I
Name**

The name of the corporation shall be Aberdeen Area Community Foundation, Inc.

**Article II
Term**

The term for which this corporation shall exist is perpetual.

**Article III
Purposes**

Section 1. The purposes for which this corporation is organized are the advancement of the civic, cultural, economic, educational and sociological interests of Aberdeen, Brown County, South Dakota and the surrounding area ("Area").

Section 2. More specifically, this corporation shall:

- a. Promote the growth of the Area by encouraging programs of a civic, social and cultural nature designed to increase the cultural and aesthetic values of the Area;
- b. Establish means of discovering, adjusting and correcting; and of preventing abuses or inequities which prevent, impair or are detrimental to the general public welfare, the expansion of commerce in and the growth of the Area;
- c. Establish programs which motivate, develop, assist and promote the education, training, development and employment of people in the Area;
- d. Promote and support educational programs and youth activities in the Area; and
- e. Receive and administer funds for such other scientific, educational and charitable purposes, to accomplish the stated purposes for all the public welfare, and to that end, to take and hold, by bequest, devise, gift, purchase or lease, either absolutely or in trust for such objects and purposes or any of them, any property, real, personal or mixed, without limitation as to amount or value, except such limitations, if any, as may be imposed by law; to sell, convey and dispose of any such property and to invest and reinvest the

principal thereof, and to deal with and expend the income therefrom for any of the before mentioned purposes, without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which property is received; to receive any property, real, personal, or mixed, in trust, under the terms of any will, deed of trust, or other trust instrument for the foregoing purposes or any of them, and in administering the same, to carry out the directions and exercise the power contained in the trust instrument under which the property is received, including the expenditure of the principal, as well as the income, for one or more of such purposes, if authorized or directed in the trust instrument under which it is received; to receive, take title to, hold, and use the proceeds and income of stocks, bonds, obligations or other securities of any corporation or corporations, domestic or foreign, but only for the foregoing purposes, or any of them; and in general, to exercise any, all and every power for which a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of south Dakota for scientific, educational, and charitable purposes, all for the public welfare, can be authorized to exercise.

Article IV Powers

Section 1. The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit nor shall it have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, trustee or individual. The balance, if any, of all money received by the corporation from its operations, after payment in full of all debts and obligations of the corporation of whatsoever kind or nature, shall be used and distributed exclusively for carrying out the purpose or purposes of the corporation set forth in Article III.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees may cause the corporation to solicit, collect, receive, accumulate, administer and disburse funds in such a manner as will, in the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees, most effectively operate to further the purpose or purposes of the corporation set forth in Article III; make contributions to any organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code; and to engage in any and all lawful activities incidental to the purposes described in Article III, except as otherwise restricted by these Articles of Incorporation.

Section 3. The corporation shall neither have nor exercise any power, nor shall it directly or indirectly engage in any activity that would prevent it from obtaining or cause it to lose exemption from federal income taxation as an organization pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Section 4. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation may consist of the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; nor shall the corporation in any manner or to any extent participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for any public office.

Section 5. The corporation shall not engage in any prohibited transactions as described in Section 503 of the Internal Revenue Code; accumulate, invest or divert income in a manner endangering its exempt status by virtue of Section 504 of the Internal Revenue Code; or engage

in any other activity which would result in the denial or loss of exemption from federal income taxation as an organization pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Section 6. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall only conduct or carry on activities permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from federal income taxation pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code; and by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Section 7. The corporation shall not engage in any activities that are unlawful under applicable federal, state or local laws.

Section 8. All references in these Articles of Incorporation to the Internal Revenue Code refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, codified as Title 26 of the United States Code, and any revisions or amendments to the same.

Article V Members

The corporation shall not have members.

Article VI Board of Trustees

Section 1. The corporation, being a non-profit corporation without members, shall have its government and management vested in a Board of Trustees which shall consist of no fewer than three (3) and no more than eleven (11) persons to be elected by the Board of Trustees in the manner prescribed in the corporate Bylaws which shall be adopted by the Board of Trustees and which may be amended from time to time by the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Trustees shall serve a three (3) year term and may serve no more than two (2) consecutive terms. The terms of the trustees should be staggered so that the terms of approximately one-third of the trustees will be due to expire each year.

Section 3. The following individuals shall constitute the initial Board of Trustees and, in addition to the terms identified in Section 2, these individuals may serve a third term which will commence upon filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the South Dakota Secretary of State and which will expire on the date set adjacent to each person's name:

Article VII Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed, in accordance with a plan of distribution adopted by the Board of Trustees, exclusively to charitable, religious, scientific and educational organizations which are engaged in affairs substantially similar to those of this corporation, and which qualify for exemption from federal income taxation pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code; to a local or state government or an agency thereof; or to the federal government or an agency thereof.

Article VIII Registered Office and Registered Agent

Section 1. There is no street address of the initial registered office of the corporation; the mailing address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Post Office Box 674, Aberdeen, South Dakota 57402.


Section 2. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation is Robert J. Fouberg; the street address of the initial registered agent is 401 South Main Street, Suite 212, Aberdeen, South Dakota 57401; and the mailing address of the initial registered agent is Post Office Box 674, Aberdeen, South Dakota 57402.

Article IX Amendment

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner authorized by law at the time of amendment.




