We provide financial support for health care programs, receive and ship donated medical supplies and equipment, recruit health care personnel for short term training projects, and collaborate with overseas partners in health care program development.

The construction of a health clinic at Gallo in the Republic of Central Africa was nearly completed by year end. In southeastern Madagascar, AVIA, a long term initiative integrating public health care, nutrition, school, and economic development progressed at Manantantely bible school where students were trained to be health educators as well as ministers. Renovations to nine buildings at Manantantely, Toby Nenilava, and Manambaro hospital were also completed. Grants provided support to rural health clinics and Ejeda hospital in Madagascar. Global Health Administrative Partners, a GHM program, worked with the Lutheran church in Camerooon and its health care system to improve its administration. US Hospital administrators traveled to Cameroon to advise in management practices and an in-country consultant was hired to provide supervisory financial services to Ngaoundere hospital.
