By-laws of Grandy Foundation

### **BY-LAWS OF**

#### THE GRANDY FOUNDATION

### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be The Grandy Foundation (the "Foundation").

### ARTICLE II PURPOSES

- Section 1. Not-for-Profit. The Foundation is organized and shall operate as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, and shall have such powers as are now and may hereafter be granted by the Illinois General Not-For-Profit Corporation Act of 1986, as amended (the "Act").
- Section 2. Purposes. The Foundation is organized to operate exclusively for the purposes set forth in its Articles of Incorporation, as amended (the "Articles of Incorporation"). The Foundation shall at all times operate in accordance with the standards and ideals set forth in the Statement of Guidelines and Priorities attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and made a part hereof by this reference (the "Statement of Priorities"). The Articles of Incorporation, Statement of Priorities and the by-laws are sometimes collectively referred to as the "Foundation's Governing Documents."
- Section 3. Rules. The Foundation and all persons acting on behalf of it shall be bound by the rules set forth in the Foundation's Governing Documents.

### ARTICLE III REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The Foundation shall have and continuously maintain in the State of Illinois a registered office and a registered agent whose office shall be identical with such registered office, and may have such other offices within or without the State of Illinois as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine.

### ARTICLE IV MEMBERS

The Foundation shall not have any members.

### ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- Section 1. General Powers. The affairs of the Foundation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, which shall supervise, control and direct the business and affairs of the Foundation; shall determine its policies or changes within the limits of the Foundation's Governing Documents and as directed by the Mission Statement attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and made a part hereof by this reference (the "Mission Statement"), shall actively promote its purposes as identified in the Articles of Incorporation and the Mission Statement; and shall have discretion in the disbursement of its funds. The Board of Directors may adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of its business as shall be deemed advisable and may, in the execution of the powers granted, appoint such agents as it may consider necessary.
- Section 2. Number and Qualifications. The Board of Directors shall be comprised of not less than three (3) nor more than eight (8) directors, as fixed from time to time, within such minimum and maximum, by a majority of the Board of Directors The class of permissible directors shall consist of Jack Miller and all descendants of Jack Miller and Audrey Miller. Directors need not be residents of Illinois, U.S. citizens nor officers of the Foundation.
- Section 3. Tenure. Each director shall hold office for a one (1) year term beginning on the date of his or her election and ending on the first anniversary of such date, or until his or her successor shall have been elected and qualified, unless prior thereto he or she becomes disqualified to hold the office of director or until the effective date of his or her resignation or removal. There shall be no limit on the number of consecutive terms an individual may serve as a director.
- Section 4. Current Directors. The Board of Directors as of the date of adoption of these by-laws is on attached Exhibit 3.

#### Section 5. Vacancies.

(a) If a vacancy in the directorship is created as a result of the death or "Permanent Disability" (hereinafter defined) of Jack Miller and such vacancy causes the number of directors of the Foundation to be less than three (3), then Sharon A. Miller, if she is then living, and Judith Nan Joy, if she is then living, shall each have the right to appoint one (1) director to fill such vacancy so that the Board of Directors is comprised of not less than three (3) nor more than four (4) directors; otherwise, if both of Sharon A. Miller and Judith Nan Joy are not then living, then such vacancy shall be filled pursuant to the provisions of subsection 5(b) of this Article.

- (b) A majority of the then acting directors shall appoint successor directors to fill any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors or any newly created directorships resulting from an increase in the number of directors. A director appointed to fill a vacancy for the unexpired term of his or her predecessor shall serve for the unexpired term of his or her predecessor in office and until his or her successor shall have been appointed and qualified.
- (c) For purposes hereof, the term "Permanent Disability" shall mean, with respect to Jack Miller either (a) the issuance of an order by a court of competent jurisdiction declaring Jack Miller to be an incompetent or a disabled person and appointing a conservator or a guardian for Jack Miller's person or property, or (b) the written certification by a physician who is on the staff of any hospital in the metropolitan Chicago, Illinois area which is affiliated with an accredited medical school that, based upon such physician's examination of Jack Miller, it is such physician's opinion that, as of such date of certification and for a period of one hundred eighty (180) days thereafter, Jack Miller is and will be substantially unable to perform his customary duties for the Foundation, or that it would seriously impair his physical or mental health to perform such duties. Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, Jack Miller shall not be considered to have a Permanent Disability solely by reason of having a physical disability which does not otherwise cause him to be substantially unable to perform his customary duties for the Foundation.
- Section 6. Regular Meetings. The Board of Directors shall hold an Annual Meeting for such business as the Board of Directors shall deem appropriate. The Board of Directors may hold regularly scheduled meetings for any other purpose as the Board of Directors shall deem appropriate. The Board of Directors may provide by resolution the time, date and place, either within or without the State of Illinois, for such Annual Meeting and other regular meetings without other notice than such resolution.
- Section 7. Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by or at the request of the President or any two (2) directors of the Foundation. The person or persons authorized to call special meetings of the Board of Directors may fix any place, either within or without the State of Illinois, for the special meeting called by them.
- Section 8. Notice. Notice of any special meeting of the Board of Directors shall state the time, date and place of the meeting and shall be given at least three (3) days prior to the date of such meeting, by written or printed notice delivered personally, by mail, by electronic mail ("e-mail") or by facsimile transmission to each director at his or her address as shown in the records of the Foundation; provided, however, in the case of a meeting held pursuant to Article V, Section 10 below, notice may be given no less than twenty-four (24) hours prior thereto. Any director may waive notice of any meeting. The attendance of a director at any meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except where a director attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of, any regular or special

meeting of the Board of Directors need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting.

- Section 9. Quorum. A majority of the directors in office shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board; provided that, if less than a majority of such number of directors are present at any meeting of the Board of Directors, a majority of the directors present may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice. The act of a majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors, unless the act of a greater number is required by law, the Articles of Incorporation or these by-laws.
- Section 10. Meeting by Communications Equipment. The members of the Board of Directors, or of any committee designated by the Board, may take any action permitted or authorized by law, the Articles of Incorporation or these by-laws pursuant to meeting through the use of a conference telephone or other communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can communicate with each other. Participation in a meeting pursuant to this section shall constitute presence in person at such meeting.
- Section 11. Informal Action. Any action which is permitted or authorized by law, the Articles of Incorporation or these by-laws to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors, or any other action which may be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors, may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing, setting forth the action taken, shall be signed by all of the directors entitled to vote with respect to the subject matter thereof. Any such consent shall have the same force and effect as a unanimous vote at a duly called and constituted meeting of the Board of Directors.
- Section 12. Resignation. Any director may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Board of Directors, the President or the Secretary of the Foundation. A resignation need not be accepted in order to be effective.
- Section 13. Removal. Any director may be removed by a majority of the then acting directors of the Foundation whenever in the sole and unquestionable judgment of a majority of the then acting directors the best interests of the Foundation would be served thereby.

### ARTICLE VI OFFICERS

- Section 1. Officers. The officers of the Foundation shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer. In addition, the Board of Directors may elect or appoint such other officers as it shall deem desirable, who shall have authority to perform the duties prescribed from time to time by the Board of Directors.
- Section 2. Election, Tenure, and Qualifications. The President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Foundation shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors at its Annual Meeting, or as soon thereafter as practicable. The

President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer shall serve one-year terms commencing at the conclusion of the Annual Meeting at which they are elected and continuing until their successors have been duly elected and qualified. There shall be no limit on the number of consecutive terms an individual may serve as an officer. An individual may hold more than one office simultaneously.

- Section 3. Resignation. Any officer may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Board of Directors, the President or the Secretary of the Foundation. A resignation need not be accepted in order to be effective.
- Section 4. Removal. Any officer may be removed from office by an affirmative vote of the Board of Directors whenever, in its judgment, the best interests of the Foundation would be served thereby, but such removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the person so removed.
- Section 5. Vacancies. A vacancy in any office shall be filled by action of the Board of Directors at the next regular or special meeting thereof. An officer elected to fill a vacancy shall serve for the unexpired term of his or her predecessor, and until his or her successor shall have been duly elected and qualified, or until his or her death, resignation, or removal.
- Section 6. President. The President shall be the principal executive officer of the Foundation, and shall, in general, supervise and control all the affairs of the Foundation. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors. The President may sign, with the Treasurer or any other proper officer of the Foundation authorized by the Board of Directors, any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts or other instruments which the Board of Directors has authorized to be executed, except documents the execution of which shall be expressly delegated by law, the Articles of Incorporation, these by-laws, or the Board of Directors to some other officer or agent of the Foundation. The President shall handle the administrative and day-to-day operation of the Foundation, and shall, in general, perform all duties customarily incident to the office of president and such other duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Board of Directors.
- Section 7. Vice-President. In the absence of the President or in the event of his inability or refusal to act, the Vice-President (or in the event there be more than one Vice-President, the Vice-Presidents, in the order designated, or in the absence of any designation, then in the order of their election) shall perform the duties of the President, and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President. Any Vice-President shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him by the President or by the Board of Directors.
- Section 8. Secretary. The Secretary shall keep minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors in one or more books maintained for that purpose, shall see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these by-laws or applicable law; shall be custodian of the corporate records; shall keep a record of the mailing address of each Director and officer of the Foundation, which addresses shall be

furnished to the Secretary by the Directors and officers; and in general, shall perform all duties incident to the office of secretary and such other duties as may be assigned from time to time by the President or the Board of Directors. The duties of the Secretary may be assigned in whole or in part to the President.

Section 9. Treasurer. The Treasurer shall be the principal accounting and financial officer of the Foundation and shall have charge of and be responsible for the maintenance of adequate books of account for the Foundation; shall supervise and be responsible for custody of all funds and securities of the Foundation and for the receipt and disbursement thereof; shall deposit all funds and securities of the Foundation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as shall be selected in accordance with the provisions of these by-laws; and shall, in general, perform all of the duties customarily incident to the office of treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or the Board of Directors. The duties of the Treasurer may be assigned in whole or in part to the President.

### ARTICLE VII COMMITTEES

- Section 1. Committees of the Board. The Board of Directors, by resolution adopted by a majority of the directors in office, may designate one or more committees, including but not limited to an Advisory Committee, each of which shall consist of two or more directors, which committees, to the extent provided in said resolution, shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the Foundation; but the designation of such committees, and the delegation thereto of authority, shall not operate to relieve the Board of Directors, or any individual director, of any responsibility imposed upon them by law.
- Section 2. Other Committees. Other committees not having and exercising the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the Foundation may be designated by a resolution adopted by a majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present. Except as otherwise provided in such resolution, members of each such committee need not be directors of the Foundation and shall be appointed by the President. Any member of such committee may be removed by the Board of Directors whenever, in its judgment, the best interests of the Foundation would be served by such removal.
- Section 3. Term of Office. Each member of a committee shall continue as such until the next annual meeting of the Board of Directors of the Foundation and until his or her successor is appointed, unless the committee shall be sooner terminated, or unless such member shall have been removed by the Board.
  - Section 4. Chair. One member of each committee shall be appointed chair.

- Section 5. Vacancies. Vacancies in the membership of any committee may be filled by appointment made in the same manner as herein provided for the original appointment to that committee.
- Section 6. Quorum and Manner of Acting. Unless otherwise provided by resolution of the Board of Directors or by the President in establishing a committee, a majority of the whole committee shall constitute a quorum, and the act of a majority of the members present and voting at a duly called meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the committee.
- Section 7. Rules. Each committee may adopt rules for its own governance not inconsistent with these by-laws or with rules adopted by the Board of Directors.
- Section 8. Advisory Committee. The Board of Directors may establish an Advisory Committee for the Foundation upon such terms as the Board of Directors deems advisable.

### ARTICLE VIII GRANTMAKING

Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, the Board of Directors shall administer and distribute all assets owned by the Foundation and contributed to the Foundation by either (1) Jack Miller; (2) any trust created by Jack Miller either during his lifetime or upon his death pursuant to his estate plan; or (3) any not-for-profit charitable organization founded by Jack Miller, in accordance with the statement of beliefs and directions of Jack Miller entitled "This I Believe: My Thoughts on Living a Good Life. Statement of Donor Intent" and attached hereto as Exhibit 4 and made a part hereot.

### ARTICLE IX FINANCE

- Section 1. Contracts. The Board of Directors may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents of the Foundation, in addition to the officers so authorized by these by-laws, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Foundation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.
- Section 2. Checks, Drafts, Etc. All checks, drafts, or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Foundation shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents of the Foundation, and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board of Directors. In the absence of such determination by the Board of Directors, such instruments shall be signed by the Treasurer, and countersigned by the President of the Foundation.

- Section 3. Deposits. All funds of the Foundation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Foundation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Directors may select.
- Section 4. Bonding. Any officer or director of the Foundation who handles funds may be required, at the Foundation's expense, to furnish an adequate surety bond approved by the Board of Directors in such amount as the Board of Directors shall prescribe.
- Section 5. Gifts. The Board of Directors may accept on behalf of the Foundation any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the Foundation.
- Section 6. Compensation, Reimbursement of Expenses and Prohibition of Loans.
- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Section, directors shall not receive any compensation for their services as directors. Nothing herein shall be construed to preclude a director from serving the Foundation in any other capacity and receiving reasonable compensation therefor.
- (b) Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, the Board of Directors may authorize reimbursement of reasonable expenses incurred by directors, officers and employees of the Foundation in connection with the performance of their duties as such, such reimbursement to be made in accordance with the procedure set forth in an expense reimbursement policy adopted by the Board of Directors.
- (c) No loans shall be made by the Foundation to any director, officer, employee, consultant, committee member or agent of the Foundation.

### ARTICLE X VOTING OF SECURITIES

The President shall have full authority, in the name and on behalf of the Foundation, to attend, act and vote at any meeting of security holders of any corporation in which the Foundation may hold securities, and at any such meeting shall possess and may exercise any and all rights and powers incident to the ownership of such securities and which, as the holder thereof, the Foundation might possess and exercise as if personally present, and may exercise such power and authority through the execution of proxies or may delegate such power and authority to any other officer, agent or employee of the Foundation.

### ARTICLE XI BOOKS AND RECORDS

The Foundation shall keep correct and complete books and records of account and shall also keep minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors and committees having

any of the authority of the Board of Directors. The books and accounts of the Foundation may be audited annually by accountants selected by the Board of Directors

### ARTICLE XII FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the Foundation shall be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors.

### ARTICLE XIII WAIVER OF NOTICE

Whenever any notice is required to be given under applicable law, the Articles of Incorporation or these by-laws, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

### ARTICLE IV INDEMNIFICATION

The Foundation shall indemnify all officers, directors and committee members of the Foundation to the full extent permitted for non-profit corporations by the Act, as amended, and shall be entitled to purchase insurance for such indemnification to the full extent as determined from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Foundation.

### ARTICLE XV AMENDMENTS

These by-laws may be altered, amended or repealed and new by-laws may be adopted by the affirmative vote of a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the directors present and voting at any duly called regular meeting or at any special meeting; provided, however, notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, Article VIII of these by-laws cannot be altered or amended without the consent of Jack Miller.

#### STATEMENT OF GUIDELINES AND PRIORITIES

### The Grandy Foundation Grant Guidelines

#### Giving Levels:

Requests from \$5,000 to \$50,000 will be considered. Multi year requests will be considered; however, payment of subsequent year awards will be contingent upon measurable and documented progress toward goals and objectives during the previous grant year.

#### Types of Awards:

The Grandy Fund supports programs and/or projects only.

#### Geographic Limitations:

Grants will only be awarded to tax-exempt charitable organizations in Northern Cook and Lake Counties of Illinois.

### Exclusions:

- No support to organizations whose programs will benefit areas located outside of Cook and Lake Counties in Illinois.
- No support to non-Jewish religious organizations.
- No support for general operations, capital/renovation or endowment funds.
- No support to organizations in existence for less than three years.
- No support to organizations currently using a fiscal/fiduciary agent.
- No grants will be considered if the application is not completed in its entirety.

# THIS I BELIEVE: MY THOUGHTS ON LIVING A GOOD LIFE STATEMENT OF DONOR INTENT

By: Jack Miller

During my lifetime, I have developed certain beliefs that have been the basis for my values and my actions throughout my lifetime. For me they have withstood the test of time. It is these beliefs that I would like to pass on to my family and which form the basis for my directions on how my funds distributed to charities should be utilized, as well as a guide not only on how to give but also how to live.

The primacy of the individual. "All men are created with certain inalienable rights...." The Declaration of Independence goes on to enumerate these rights as, "...the right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness." I believe that when the founders said "all men" they meant every single individual in the universe regardless of sex, creed or color. And when they talked of, "life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness," they were talking of the right each individual had to their own life, their own liberty and their own pursuit of happiness. They also stressed the sanctity of private property. These ideas amongst others were the basis for our form of government.

I believe in maximum individual responsibility and minimum restriction of personal liberty, opportunity and enterprise. I also believe in free markets and limited government. The caveat here is that each individual must accord every other individual those same rights. Rights are vested in the individual and not in any government or religion. What rights the government (or religion) has are those rights freely given to it by individuals. Governments (or religions) have no inherent rights!

We are responsible for our own actions. With the possible exception of individuals with extreme mental disorders, each of us is responsible for our own actions. I very strongly believe that, "Actions have consequences and each of us is responsible for our own actions." I believe in free will. Throughout our lives we make decisions and choose courses of action that yield differing results. Each of us must live with the consequences of those choices. Not knowing what the consequence of a particular choice may be is no excuse for avoiding the consequence of that choice. It is seldom too late to make another, better, choice. Choosing to get an education, to learn, to work hard, to focus on achievement, to be self-supporting, to conserve, to save and to wisely invest money are just a few examples of conscious choices each individual makes during their lifetime.

I am unbelievably fortunate to have been born a Jew. While I am somewhat of an agnostic, or perhaps a deist at most, I believe that the Jewish tradition, forged over thousands of years, under both very good and very trying conditions, is a great set of guidelines by which to lead our lives. This tradition deserves our support. We, and the world at large, would be much poorer without this tradition. So I believe that we should support Jewish causes and, in particular, the survival of this rich tradition. Anything that threatens that survival should be considered bad. Anything that enhances it should be considered a positive. In addition, support of Israel is critical in order to protect Jews around the world and to be a sanctuary for all Jews when needed.

That does not mean that every "Jewish" cause should be supported. Some Jews have been socialists and communists, or extreme "liberals" (in today's sense in the United States) claiming that this is the Jewish tradition. But I believe they misread the

Jewish tradition. Despite this, the only segment of Jewish religious groups that I do not feel should be supported is the <u>ultra</u> orthodox segment, which, in my opinion, falls under my prohibition of supporting cults of any kind. I believe that cults take from the individual the freedom to make their own choices, the freedom to secure their own "<u>rights.</u>" I believe it is critical to avoid giving up one's personal reasoning ability, freedom and identity to be a part of any kind of cult; doing so destroys one's life.

In my mind, the word "cults" refers to causes, groups or individuals that, or who, use mind control techniques that cause people to not think clearly and cause them to cease to think for themselves. They expect a major commitment from their members far beyond any norm. They can be evil and dangerous and manipulative. Many have a very strong religious bias far beyond the norm.

I am equally fortunate to have been born in the United States of America. I am deeply indebted to my grandparents for having the courage to leave Russia and come to America. For I truly believe that no other country in the world has as fine a charter as this country, dedicated to the belief in the primacy of the rights of man as opposed to those of the state or church. Many, from within, as well as from outside this country, have criticized us for not fully living up to those goals, but no other country has had them as goals and no other country has made as much progress toward their achievement as we have.

Unfortunately, there has been a concerted effort to rewrite our Constitution without the benefit of having to get the citizens' approval through the amendment procedure provided in that same Constitution. Although the legislative and executive branches initiate many of the problems, this has been done primarily through judicial

actions reinterpreting the meaning of the Constitution. I believe that the judicial branch of the government should interpret the law as based on the Constitution, not re-write it based on their beliefs and prejudices, by stretching the meaning of the Constitution.

The Declaration of Independence and the Constitution are the finest documents ever written supporting the rights of individuals and are the best basis for government that imperfect man has ever created. They should be preserved.

People deserve to keep and enjoy the fruits of their labor. I believe that the Free Enterprise Capitalistic System is the finest economic system ever devised by man. It provides each individual with the maximum reward for his or her efforts, which, in turn, motivates individuals to be more innovative and more productive and to most effectively channel resources. The overall result is a higher and higher standard of living for more and more individual workers as well as owners. No other economic system comes close.

Unfortunately, there are always those who continuously want to regulate this system through excessive legislation and excessive taxation. Their goal is the redistribution of wealth, toward a more socialist approach. We must fight to preserve and expand the free market capitalistic system in our country.

"Take what you will, quoth God. Pay for it and take it." I have always believed that it is our responsibility to support and pay for those things we want. So, for example, if we would want a Temple for a child or grandchild to be Bar or Bat Mitzvahed or married in, then we should begin supporting a Temple at an early period in our life so it is there when we want (need) it. We shouldn't join just a few years before the need and quit immediately afterward. This concept applies to many other things in our life and society.

This world is filled with "putters" and "takers". We should be "putters". Within the context of my beliefs, we should always attempt to add more to the "world" than we take from it.

While I believe whatever one chooses to do for others and for society is each individual's choice to make, I also believe that we should give back to repay for what we have received. Often, we have been helped in some way. And we may not be able to repay that help directly to those who helped us. But we can repay it by helping someone else. For example, my Dad helped me get started by taking phone calls and letting me use his chicken store to pack orders. When Harvey joined me, Uncle Herb let us use his basement and unused coal bin as a warehouse and office. My father-in-law, Jerry, as well as Uncle Herb and Dad, all talked to their customers to get them to buy from us. I, in turn, have tried to help others. I believe we all should do this.

We should feel a sense of obligation because we have been successful in good part because others have created a society in which we could be successful. "We stand on the shoulders of those who came before us." What we do with our lives is up to us.

Note: In fulfilling the causes under one belief, the trust should not support a cause that is in contradiction to another belief. There are no contradictions between my various beliefs, and if there seem to be, then the causes (within one belief or the other) should be carefully re-examined under the scrutiny of my overall beliefs.

And, finally, I have learned and believe that wealth is not an embarrassment or a stumbling block. Used thoughtfully and properly it is a tremendous enabler. It enables one to live a good life, to pursue one's real interests, whether in business or in other areas, to contribute to society in many ways.

Where it is truly an "embarrassment" is when one uses it only to enable one to lead a life of indolence.

A very wise man told me once that, "He who has not worked hard to earn the money must work hard to deserve it."

Finally, one obligation of inheriting wealth is to try hard to maintain and build the wealth for future generations while using it as described.

My hope for all my descendants is that they each live a good, a productive and a very satisfying life and that the wealth I pass on in some way helps each of them to do so.

It is with great love and a great deal of thought that I have written this document and prepared my trusts. But the best that can be said is that, I have done the best that I could.
