

General Operating Grants

A limited number of general operating grants may be awarded

- 1) to exemplary single-program organizations
- to organizations with a range of expertise that is called upon by a variety of public and private agencies
- to cultural organizations that provide resources to under-served regions.

Grants are not available to support:

- Endowments
- · Fund-raising events
- · Debt or deficit reduction
- · Political campaigns
- · Religious purposes
- · Individuals
- Taxing bodies to accomplish programs that fall within the normal scope of their responsibilities
- Generally, the Foundation does not fund research or planning projects unless they are a well-integrated step to program implementation.

GRAND VICTORIA FOUNDATION GUIDELINES

Read the guidelines carefully to determine eligibility and whether your activities match our mission, grant making programs, and funding priorities.

ORGANIZATION ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be well managed, fiscally healthy 501 (c)(3) public charities or certified public institutions. The Foundation will only consider requests from qualified applicants that are engaged in one or more of the activities listed in the grant making programs section of these guidelines.

GEOGRAPHIC ELIGIBILITY

Local: Applicants must be operating in Kane, DuPage, Lake, McHenry, Kendall, Will, Winnebago, DeKalb or suburban Cook counties and be engaged in one or more of the activities that the Foundation supports. Please note that efforts directed solely to Chicago neighborhoods typically are not supported.

Regional: Applicants must be operating in the Chicago Metropolitan area and be collaboratively engaged in one or more of the activities that the Foundation supports to address issues that are regional in scope. Examples include air quality, transportation, and growth management.

Statemule: Applicants must be operating in Illinois and engaged in child care, land use and protection, and/or workforce development efforts that impact a substantial portion of Illinois.

MISSION

The mission of Grand Victoria Foundation is to assist communities in their efforts to pursue systemic solutions to problems in specific areas of education, economic development and the environment

GRANT MAKING PROGRAMS

Within each program area, the Foundation is particularly interested in projects that:

Education

- Because of our emphasis on regional solutions, the Foundation generally directs more resources to support regional projects than to programs that are locally focussed.
