Statement 4 - Form 990-EZ, Part III - Organization's Primary Exempt Purpose

Description

The purpose of the organization shall be to promote pavement preservation as a proactive approach in maintaining our highways; to educate the public on the value of pavement preservation in reducing the use of new virgin road materials, reducing energy costs and reducing green house gases; and to conduct research and studies on pavement preservation methodologies.

Statement 5 - Form 990-EZ, Part III, Line 28 - Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

Description

The organization seeks to educate, influence and inform the public, agencies, trade associations, legislators, and preservation partnerships about the benefits of preserving our existing highway system in an acceptable manner to users and freight haulers. The goal of preservation is achieved by advocating national policies; by promotional activities like trade shows, and other venues; and by supporting research programs like the National Center for Pavement Preservation at Michigan State University in accordance with the Preservation Research Roadmap recently published by the Federal Highway administration through grants and project solicitations.
