THE NOMINATION COMMITTEE DELEVOPS A RECOMMENDATION LIST AND PRESENTS THE LIST TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS ANNUALLY FOR REVIEW AND DISCUSSION THOSE DETERMINED AS VIABLE CANDIDATES ARE RANKED IN ORDER OF PREFERENCE AS THERE MAY BE MORE CANDIDATES THAN OPEN POSITIONS. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SENDS A LETTER TO EACH NOMINEE OUTLINING THE AGENCY AND ASKING THEM TO CONSIDER JOINING THE BOARD. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MEETS WITH THE NOMINEE AND FORMALLY OFFERS THE SEAT ON THE BOARD. IF THE NOMINEE ACCEPTS, THE TERM STARTS IN AUGUST AND BEGINS ATTENDING MEETINGS STARTING IN SEPTEMBER. DEPENDING UPON THE NUMBER OF OPEN POSITIONS ON THE BOARD, THERE ARE GENERALLY 3-5 NEW MEMBERS A YEAR. EACH BOARD MEMBER CAN SERVE UP TO TWO CONSECUTIVE 3-YEAR TERMS.
