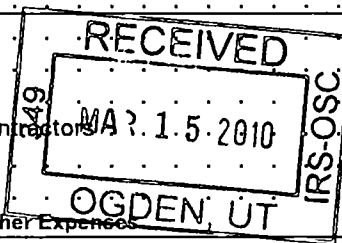



(1) The purpose of this association is to maintain a union of individuals interested in sport fishing in the waters of the Great Lakes and adjoining waters. The association shall be non-profit under the statutes of the State of Wisconsin and no part of the income or receipts of the association shall be used to the benefit of any one member of the association.

(2) Betterment of conditions of those individuals engaged in sport fishing in the Great Lakes by fostering and promoting the general welfare of the lakes and the fish therein, and encouraging the constant adherence to boating safety

(3) To better acquaint the public with the conservation projects of the association and to provide suggestions in boating safety and procurement of game fish within the waters of the Great Lakes and adjoining waters

(4) To develop a higher degree of game fishing techniques through the exchange of ideas, information, and incidents or practical experience among its members.

(5) To promote better understanding by the cultivation of personal acquaintance with others engaged in sport fishing in the Great Lakes and adjoining waters.

(6) To provide, through its members, safeguards to the public for fishing and boating in the Great Lakes and the adjoining waters

(7) To represent and act for members before divisions of the government and before public and private organizations whose activities affect sport fishing in the Great Lakes and adjoining waters, with the purpose of protecting these waters against pollution and exploitation by commercial, industrial and other organizations, legislation and regulations detrimental to sport fishing or inimical to the public welfare, and other conditions which might impair efforts of any member to fish the waters of the Great Lakes and adjoining waters for pleasure, with due regard of the responsibilities to the public.

ARTICLE III - Members

The members of this association shall be of good moral character and governed by the rules set forth in the By-Laws
