The New Harvest Foundation, Inc. (Foundation) is a non-profit, benevolent and educational organization incorporated in 1984. Its humanitarian mission is to raise and distribute funds to benefit gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender causes in south central Wisconsin. The significant accounting policies followed are described below to enhance the usefulness of the financial statements to the reader.

**NOTE 1 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

**Basis of Presentation**

The Foundation is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets

*Unrestricted net assets*—Net assets that are not restricted by donors. Designations are voluntary board-approved segregations of unrestricted net assets for specific purposes, projects, or investments

*Temporarily restricted net assets*—Net assets whose use has been limited by donor-imposed time restrictions or purpose restrictions

*Permanently restricted net assets*—Net assets that have been restricted by donors to be maintained by the Foundation in perpetuity.

**Promises to Give**

Unconditional promises to give are recognized as support or gains in the period received and as assets, decreases in liabilities, or expenses depending on the form of the benefits received. Conditional promises to give are recognized only when the conditions on which they depend are substantially met and the promises become unconditional. Uncollectible promises are written off after management has used reasonable collection efforts and determines the promises will not be collected. All unconditional promises to give at December 31, 2009 and 2008 are receivable in less than one year.

**Equipment**

Purchases of equipment are recorded at cost. Equipment, if donated, is recorded as at its estimated fair value. Equipment is depreciated using the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of the assets.

**Contributions**

Contributions that are restricted by the donor are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets if the restrictions expire (that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished) in the reporting period in which the revenue is recognized. All other donor-restricted contributions are reported as increases in temporarily or permanently restricted net assets, depending on the nature of the restrictions. When a restriction expires, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statements of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

**Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

**Income Tax Status**

The Foundation is an exempt public charity under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and therefore is not subject to federal and state income or franchise taxes. The Foundation's federal exempt organization returns are subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service, generally for three years after they are filed. With few exceptions, the Foundation is no longer subject to such examinations for tax years before 2006.

**Date of Management's Review**

Management has evaluated subsequent events through June 7, 2010, the date which the financial statements were available to be issued.

**Expense Allocation**

The costs of providing various programs and other activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the statements of activities and in the statement of functional expenses. Accordingly, certain costs have been allocated among the program services and supporting activities benefited.

**NOTE 2 – OPERATING LEASE**

---

The Foundation rents office space on a month-to-month basis. Monthly lease charges are \$100. Lease expense was \$1,200 for 2009 and 2008.

**NOTE 3 – EQUIPMENT**

The Foundation has equipment with a capitalized value of \$3,228 that was fully depreciated at December 31, 2009 and 2008.

**NOTE 4 – JOINT COSTS**

The costs of the Foundation's newsletter have been allocated between program and fundraising expenses. The total newsletter costs allocated in the statements of activities was \$4,362 and \$7,138 for 2009 and 2008.

**Agency Endowment**

The Foundation has established an agency endowment fund at Madison Community Foundation (MCF). The Foundation recognizes the fair value of contributions when received. The Foundation acknowledges that, by virtue of the governing instrument of MCF, the Board of Governors of MCF has the authority to modify any restriction or condition on the distribution of assets from the Funds if, in the reasonable judgment of the Board of Governors, such restriction or condition becomes unnecessary, incapable of fulfillment or inconsistent with the charitable needs of the community served by MCF. MCF maintains legal ownership of the Funds.

The Foundation's endowment consists of funds designated by the board of directors to function as endowments. As required by generally accepted accounting principles, net assets associated with endowment funds, including funds designated by the board of directors to function as endowments, are classified and reported based on the existence or absence of donor-imposed restrictions. Since the agency endowment funds resulted from internal designations and are not donor-restricted, they are classified and reported as unrestricted net assets.

The Foundation recognizes the fair value of contributions as support when received and recognizes transfers to the agency endowment as decreases in cash and increases in an asset called "Beneficial interest in assets held by Madison Community Foundation" when the funds are transferred to MCF.

The assets of the agency endowment are invested in a diverse mix of equity and debt securities. MCF has adopted an investment policy that attempts to generate highly competitive investment returns that support grantmaking while ensuring that each fund's principal growth equals or exceeds the rate of inflation.

**NOTE 7 – FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS (continued)**

The Foundation's beneficial interest in assets held by MCF represents an agreement between the Foundation and MCF in which the Foundation transfers assets to MCF in exchange for future distributions. The beneficial interest is not actively traded and significant other observable inputs are not available. Thus, the fair value of the beneficial interest is measured at the proportional share of the underlying assets as reported to the Foundation by MCF. Little information about those assets is released publicly. The estimated value does not necessarily represent the amounts that may be ultimately realized due to the occurrence of future circumstances that cannot be reasonably determined.

**NOTE 8 – BEQUEST**

In 2008 the Foundation received an unrestricted contribution of \$82,295 bequeathed from the estate of Henry X Dudek \$2,295 and \$80,000 was received in December 2009 and 2008. This contribution constituted 82% of the Foundation's revenue in 2008.
