However, in November and December 2009 the employer confirmed that the record keeper for its other deferred compensation plans has systems and procedures in place to avoid similar failures. The operational failure is eligible for the correction under the terms of Notice 2008-113, and the employer has taken all actions required, and otherwise met all requirements, for such correc
