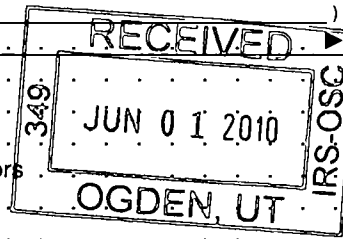



UNUSUAL GRANTS

In 2009, the Chenrezig Fund Inc received two unusual grants: 1) a \$50,000 grant and 2) a \$30,000 grant.

These grants were cash grants paid in the form of personal checks.

These grants were unusual and unexpected and a substantial contribution for our small not-for-profit corporation. Most of our many donors contribute less than \$1,000, many less than \$100.

We understand that both grants were attracted by our publically supported activities over 10 years of operation.

These contributions, individually or together, are large enough to endanger our status as normally meeting the 33 1/3% public support test. We therefore excluded these unusual grants from the 33 1/3% public support test for 2009.

The two grantors are separate individuals and are not related in any way. Both grantors are disinterested persons.

The donors had no role in founding or operating the Chenrezig Fund, Inc. and had no position of authority or control in the organization. One of the donors had previously made a large unusual grant to the Chenrezig Fund, Inc. but made no such contribution in 2008.

Before receiving these contributions, the Chenrezig Fund, Inc. had carried on its actual program of public solicitation and exempt activities since it was given 501(c)(3) status in 2000. From the beginning, it has attracted a significant amount of public support. With or without these unusual grants, the Chenrezig Fund, Inc. would have continued to attract a significant amount of public support and to continue to carry on its exempt activities.

In the years prior to receiving these unusual grants, the organization met the 33 1/3% public support test each year and in the future will be able to meet the public support test by excluding these two unusual grants.

The Chenrezig Fund is a charitable and educational organization devoted to assisting Tibetans throughout the world in their efforts to survive as a distinct people and maintain their unique and ancient cultural heritage. The Chenrezig Fund accomplishes this end by providing support for selected charitable projects initiated by people of Tibetan origin.

Projects are selected by the Board of Directors and may include cultural preservation, education, social service, and health care. Support activities include appeals for donations and grants from individuals, groups, corporations, and foundations; appeals for in-kind donations; appeals for volunteer professional services; and presentations and promotional literature to increase public awareness of the Tibetan projects and their needs.

Support efforts for selected projects are administered separately by Board-approved directors. All support activities are subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
