	The union through employees, members and specialists negotiated approximately 140 contracts covering 5000 members. The
	objective of these contract negotiations are to provide members with improved working conditions, job protections, better benefit
	and higher wages. The union through employees, members and specialists resolved 300+ grievances of which 57 were referre
	to attorneys or other specialists for assistance. 36 of these grievances went to arbitration. The objective of pursing these
	grievances include protecting workers jobs, improving the working condition of members and to ensure the contract terms are
	enforced. The union through employees and member volunteers ran 16 seperate organizing campaigns. Some of these
	campaigns resulted in new contracts, others continue as ongoing campaigns. The objective of organizing campaigns are to
	increase member density to improve bargaining strength and expanding union membership into new employers and
	organizations to improve working conditions of people not yet covered by union contract. Other programs include: 1) Member
	training in contract enforcement, organizing and community outreach, 2) Conferences and convention to ensure member
	involvement in governance, setting the mission of the union, and increasing member involvement.
