360 Communities, formerly known as Community Action Council, Inc., a Minnesota nonprofit corporation existing under the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, hereby amends and restates its Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I NAME

(The name of this corporation shall be: 360 Communities (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND AUTHORITY

)

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, as contemplated and permitted by Sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). Within the framework and limitations of the foregoing, the Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively to change lives and strengthen communities.

For such purposes, and not otherwise, the Corporation shall have and exercise only such powers as are required by and are consistent with the foregoing purposes, and such other powers that are consistent with the foregoing purposes and that are afforded to the Corporation by the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act and by any future laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto. Provided, however, that all such powers

of the Corporation shall be exercised only so that the activities of the Corporation shall be exclusively within the contemplation of Sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Code, and of Section 290.05 of the Minnesota Statutes: provided further, however, that the reference herein to Section 290.05 of the Minnesota Statutes shall not permit, and shall not be taken as permitting, the Corporation to have or exercise any power which is not within the contemplation of Section 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Code; and provided finally, however, that the Corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by a corporation that is exempt from federal income taxes under Section 501(a) of the Code or by a corporation that is described in, and contributions to which are deductible for federal income tax purposes under. Section 170(c)(2) of the Code

All references in these Articles of Incorporation to a particular section of the Code shall mean and include, as now enacted or as hereafter amended, such section and any provision of federal law as is or may hereafter be applicable or cognate to such section; and the reference in this Article to Section 290 05 of the Minnesota Statutes shall mean and include, as now enacted or as hereafter amended, such provision and any provision of Minnesota law as is or may hereafter be applicable or cognate to such provision.

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ARTICLE III NO PECUNIARY GAIN, PROPAGANDA

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall mure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any director or officer of the Corporation, or any private individual, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the

carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under 501(c)(3) of the Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV PERPETUAL EXISTENCE

The period of duration of corporate existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

The Corporation may be dissolved in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, and after the payment of all liabilities and obligations of the Corporation and all costs and expenses incurred by the Corporation in connection with such dissolution, and subject always to the further provisions of this Article VIII, any remaining assets shall be distributed to and among such one or more corporations, associations, trusts, foundations, and institutions that are then in existence. that are organized and operated exclusively for one or more purposes described in Section 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Code, that are described in Section 501(c)(3) and in Section 509(a)(1), (2) or (3) of the Code, and that are exempt from federal income taxes under Section 501(a) of the Code, all in such proportions as shall be determined (1) by the Board of Directors of the Corporation of the dissolution of the Corporation is not required by the laws of the State of Minnesota then in existence to be conducted under court supervision, or (2) by a court of competent jurisdiction if the dissolution of the Corporation is required by the laws of the State of Minnesota then in existence to be conducted under court supervision.
