Regions Hospital Foundation is helping to fund the hospital's efforts - Breast Cancer Care RHF received \$18,086 from the Hope Chest for Breast Cancer Foundation and the Breast Cancer Partnership Fund of the Minneapolis Foundation to help low income breast cancer patients meet their basic and cosmetic needs. The Anna M. Heilmaier Charitable Foundation donated \$10,000 that was split between the programs for the Cancer Care Center and the Breast Health Center. Additionally in 2009, RHF secured \$25,000 in private funding to help fund a stereotactic breast biopsy machine. Language Services. RHF secures charitable donations to assist with the costs related to Interpreter Services at Regions Hospital and HealthPartners. Clinics. RHF raised \$3,000 through private funding for interpreter services training in 2009. Professionally trained medical language interpreters are on-site to serve patients in the most common.

Vietnamese and American Sign Language Additionally in 2009, Regions Hospital began a one-year pilot of a video remote interpreting (VRI) system. The VRI system allows care providers on select units to create a two-way visual and auditory link, connecting them and their patients on one end with a medical interpreter in a remote location. RHF raised \$80,000 in 2009 for this pilot project. Community Giving. In 2009, Regions Hospital and Group Health employees donated over \$497,000 to RHF's annual Sharing at Work campaign which raises funds for patient care, research and medical education. With a HealthPartners match, the campaign raised over \$1 million. Patient care funds from the campaign were split between the Wishing Well Fund which provides basic necessities.
