#### Certified Mail Instructions

Attached are the *Receipt for Certified Mail* and US Postal Service Form 3811 – return receipt postcard – that we have obtained for you to send your Form 990-PF via Certified Mail.

We have printed your name and address on the back of the green Form 3811.

Peel the tape on the left and right of the back of the Form 3811 and attach it to the front of the envelope in which you are mailing your Form 990-PF. Although the address of the Rhode Island Attorney General, Providence, Rhode Island is printed on the Form 3811, you still need to address the envelope in the normal manner. This postcard will be mailed to you from the Office Rhode Island Attorney General, Rhode Island. It will be signed by the recipient and date-stamped by the Office of the Rhode Island Attorney General. This is your proof of filing, and should be attached to your file copy of the Form 990-PF.

Remove "peel and stick" bottom portion of *Receipt for Certified Mail* and attach to top of envelope. Follow instructions on *Receipt for Certified Mail* as to where to fold the receipt. After taking the envelope to the post office, they will give you the remainder of this receipt. Keep this with your copy of the Form 990-PF.

Take envelope to post office where they will weigh the package and charge you the postage plus the certified mail fee. The certified mail fee together with the return receipt fee is \$4.90. The typical total cost for this will be approximately \$6.90.
