Grant Guidelines:

The Archie D. & Bertha H. Walker Foundation places primary emphasis upon grants to programs dealing with chemical dependency, chiefly alcoholism, upon children and their development.

The Trustees also consider grant proposals in areas of long-standing These interests include programs in the arts, Foundation interests. especially ones with which the Foundation has been historically associated, and programs addressing the treatment of racism, prejudice. and exclusivity.

In addition, approximately 20 grants of \$1,000 each are made annually in the areas of health, culture, conservation, recreation, education, international affairs, and social welfare. The total of these awards normally is limited to \$20,000 (not including matching grants).

The Foundation customarily limits its grant making activities to the State of Minnesota. Grants are usually awarded for a one-year period. The Foundation will ordinarily give preference to grants for programs over grants for capital needs. No grants are made either to individuals or private foundations.

Grant applications should include a description of the organization, the qualifications of responsible personnel, description of the project, its significance, a budget, and financial projections showing continuity of support if the request is for a new program. A copy of the organization's application must include a one-page project summary and budget submitted on the form provided by the Foundation.
