Emergency room and transport services, clinics in underserved areas, the Shaken Baby Task Force and numerous other support and screening programs are all services that operate at negative margins Jennie Edmundson and 20 other organizations in the community have united in the Shaken Baby Task Force in a community effort to prevent Shaken Baby Syndrome The Task Force, led by members of the staff of Jennie Edmundson Hospital, developed a copyrighted curriculum, video and safebaby org website and the nation's only 24-hour dedicated crying baby hotline. The video "Shaken Babies" Shattered Lives" is free on request and has beensent to requesters in 24 states and five countries outside the United States including Canada, the Phillippines, the Netherlands and Russia Shaken Baby Syndrome (SBS) is caused by the violent shaking of a baby or a young child, causing the head to flop back and forth. This whiplash motion can slam the brain against the inside of the skull and tear blood vessels. Brain swelling and internal bleeding from injury causes brain tissue to tear Babies under the age of 6 months are at the highest risk of SBS, but it can affect children up to the age of 3 depending on muscle development Staff make regularly presentations at schools from elementary through college, community agencies, civic groups and church groups on the topic of shaken baby syndrome. In 2009 the helpline received 130 calls from caregivers, parents and baby sitters. Over 36,400 copies of educational materials were distributed Parents are provided with a "new parent resource" bag which includes helpful information about services and resources available to them The family resource center at Jennie Edmundson Hospital provided information to patients, community and employees about smoking cessation in an effort to move the indicator relating to lung cancer and lung diseases. In 2009, 322 such materials were given out Jennie Edmundson Hospital holds an annual free skin cancer screening. Physicians conduct a spot check or full-body exam, but participants are not required to undergo a complete exam if it is not desired. A copy of the screening results are sent to each participant. Information on the prevention of skin cancer is also available. Jennie edmundson's commitment to southwest iowa extends to a wide variety of other annual screening programs covering prostate cancer, colorectal cancer, breast cancer and cervical cancer in addition, physicians and hospital staff provide educational programs to organizations and at community events

The Health System follows established guidelines for placing certain patient balances with collection agencies. Self pay accounts are charged against the allowance for uncollectible accounts at the time of transfer to the collection agency During fourth quarter 2008, management refined its uninsured discount policy and related processes which caused a decrease in bad debt expense and corresponding increase in administrative adjustments, a component of contractual allowances.
