and special meeting of the lodge in a minute book which is kept for an indefinite period with most being kept from the
time that the lodge was chartered by the Grand Lodge. During a regular meeting of Mosaic Lodge, various committees
will give a verbal report of their activities, if any. This report is entered into the minutes of that meeting. Any recomenda-
tion made by a committee must be voted upon by the members of the Lodge present at a regular meeting
