Additional Information

Expenses shared with 501(c)(4) organization -

The organization shares facilities, the cost of employees, and other expenses with Missouri Progressive Vote Coalition, Inc. (MPVC). The organization (MCEF) reimburses MPVC periodically for its portion of shared expenses based on time spent on MCEF projects. Shared expenses include rent, salaries, payroll taxes, supplies, insurance, postage, telephone, etc. Payments are made by check. In 2009 a total of \$324,020 was due to MPVC for shared operating expenses. A contract is signed each year between the two organizations outlining the terms of the agreement. There is no MCEF board member who is also on the MPVC board.

Explanation of Line 18, page 1

The organization recognizes grant revenue in accordance with SFAS No. 116, the accounting pronouncement that requires some types of grant revenue to be recorded as of the award date regardless of when the expenses will be incurred. At any time, the unspent amounts of grants awarded in that year and previous years are recorded as Temporarily Restricted Net Assets on the Statement of Financial Position (balance sheet). The difference between temporarily restricted net assets and total net assets is the unrestricted portion.

Due to the timing differences of when grant revenue and the related expenses are recognized, the change in net assets for a year on line 18 doesn't necessarily indicate the actual excess of revenue or expenses for the year. In 2009 Temporarily Restricted Net Assets decreased by \$28,728. The decrease represents the amount of revenue recognized in previous years for the expenses that were incurred in 2009.

Part III – Statement of Program Accomplishments

1.) Capacity Building

During its continuing effort to engage the citizens of Missouri, the staff at Missouri Citizen Education Fund (hereafter, MCEF) began to develop relationships with small business owners, spokespersons, ally organizations and community leaders in target areas around the state who are affected by issues surrounding the critical issues of the day. Additionally, MCEF developed an effective team.

2.) Leadership development

MCEF continued its civic engagement work in 2009 by recruiting and re-enlisting young activists on college campuses across the state. MCEF also continued its successful campaign to recruit volunteers and activists to assist in engaging the public about public policy. The recruitment of leaders among the impoverished and underrepresented citizens of Missouri was emphasized here.

3.) Communications and Outreach

MCEF used its organizational resources and topical knowledge to conduct trainings with state and local community leaders, volunteers, and opinion leaders on how to effectively reach out on specific and critical policy issues. MCEF used its considerable resources among the state's media outlets to submit letters to editors, op-eds and media actions and events on critical issues of public policy. MCEF received significant media coverage as a result of this work.

4.) Fellowship

MCEF hosted a fellowship sponsored by one of its organizational affiliates. MCEF's fellow was successful at framing the debate about contemporary budget and economic policy through the use of earned media events focused around the need to invest in America's future, develop and educate a base of volunteers to carry out actions in order to frame the public debate about the issues of the day, and to build a leadership track of individuals within that base to play an active role in MCEF's ongoing efforts on tax and budget issues.
