Adoni Roi Congregation, Tel Aviv, Israel

Total gifts \$ 7,500

Jewish Messianic Church that serves the Tel Aviv area. They have a street ministry and hold regular worship services each week, bible study classes and are very active in local mission & outreach work, through their full time pastors and members.

KAM Publishing, Jerusalem, Israel
