THE ORGANIZATION CURRENTLY MAINTAINS A QUASI-ENDOWMENT OF APPROXIMATELY \$15,000,000 (AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2009). THE ENDOWMENT WAS NOT BUILT BY LARGE GIFTS, BUT WAS CREATED BY SMALL ADDITIONS FROM SURPLUSES GENERATED FROM ANNUAL OPERATIONS OVER MANY YEARS. PRIOR TO 2004, THE ORGANIZATION RECEIVED A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT OF FUNDING FROM A VARIETY OF INDIVIDUALS AND STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES. THE ORGANIZATION'S PUBLIC SUPPORT PERCENTAGES WERE 52%, 48% AND 38% FOR 2003, 2004 AND 2005, RESPECTIVELY. ADDITIONALLY, THE ORGANIZATION IS CURRENTLY PROVIDING THE USE OF THE MAJORITY OF ITS FACILITY IN ST. LOUIS AT NO CHARGE TO HAVEN HOUSE, A LOCAL 501(C)(3) ORGANIZATION. THE VALUE OF THIS IN-KIND DONATION IS APPROXIMATELY \$300,000 ANNUALLY.

THE ORGANIZATION'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS IS COMPRISED OF 14 MEMBERS (11 OF WHICH RETAIN VOTING RIGHTS) THAT ARE COMMUNITY LEADERS. NONE OF THE CURRENT BOARD MEMBERS HAVE CONTRIBUTED SUBSTANTIAL FUNDS OR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE ORGANIZATION WITHIN THE LAST FIVE YEARS.
