Students are able to complete year one without going on to complete year 2. The School of Revival was established in August 2009, with 12 full time (15 hours per week) and 3 part time students on the course.

It is designed to be a 2-year course, although students can complete year 1 only. Year 1 is foundational, with a focus on the values of Catch the Fire Ministries. Year 2 is more in-depth study on the theology, principles and practices of church leadership and government. ii) International Leaders School of Ministry - a 1-week school held in Raleigh, similar to those run by other churches in our denomination, designed to train, equip and refresh Christian ministers and lay persons, with an emphasis on the Catch the Fire values and receiving from the Holy Spirit. iii) Prophetic Equipping Seminar - a 3-day seminar run in 2009 to train and equip church leaders and lay persons in hearing the voice of God and ministering in the prophetic. iv) Hearing the Voice of God seminar - an annual 1.5 day seminar run to train and equip lay persons in how to hear the voice of God more clearly. v) Women's Ablaze Conference - an annual 1 day women's conference to provide training and equipping for women Line 4d - Other program services In addition to those listed above, the church also continued to run "Immersion Weekends" and "Leaders on Fire" as part of the church's leadership development program. Leaders on Fire 1 & 2 are leadership development courses that run for 13 weeks twice per year, 1.5 hours per week. Immersion weekends are residential weekends that provide training on the church's core values. Note that in program services expenses we do not allocate salary costs of staff time. Part V, Line 2 - Duncan Smith (President) & Robert Savel (VP/ Treasurer) have a business relationship with each other. Part VI, Line 11A - Review of Form 990.
