Foundation Mission

To provide educational experiences related to careers, finance and nutrition for individuals to encourage and enable them to be self-reliant, productive members of society.

Foundation Purpose and Geographic Scope

The Leightman Maxey Foundation is a private foundation that distributes grants in support of nonprofit organizations whose services are in line with the mission of the Foundation. Funding priority is given to those organizations serving "at risk" clients.

The Foundation is particularly interested in supporting educational endeavors with any of the following focuses:

Career: work programs, employable skills programs, employment seeking

preparation

Finance: budgeting, judicious use of credit, living within one's means Nutrition: shopping for and preparing healthy, economical meals

Grants may be awarded in any of the following three categories:

Capacity Building - The intention of a capacity building grant is to strengthen a nonprofit's performance and improve organizational effectiveness. The following are examples of activities that would fall under this category: strategic planning, organizational assessment, board development, collaboration and strategic restructuring, marketing and communications, technology and information systems, volunteer recruitment and management

General Operating - The intention of an unrestricted general operating grant is to support a nonprofit organization's mission rather than a specific project/program. These represent funds needed to sustain day to day operations. The following are examples of activities that would fall under this category: salaries, office expenses (rent, utilities, etc.)

Project/Program - The intention of a project/program grant is to provide funds for a specific endeavor. It may be either a one time event and/or ongoing. The following are examples of activities that would fall under this category: job skills training, financial education classes, nutrition/cooking classes for clients

Multiyear grants may be awarded. They will be limited to two years with the second year of funding being contingent upon a satisfactory report being received from the grantee at the end of the first years funding period.

The Foundation limits its funding to Southern Oregon, specifically Jackson, Josephine, Klamath and Curry counties.

Eligibility Considerations and Requirements

Grant requests are considered only from organizations that are established nonprofit, tax-exempt, charitable organizations and public entities in any of the above named four counties. The Foundation will consider only one grant request from the same organization in a twelve month period, unless an additional request is invited by the Foundation. A final report for any previous funding must be received by the Foundation before another application from a previous grantee will be considered.

The Leightman Maxey Foundation generally makes grants up to \$15,000.00. The Foundation favors proposals with specific goals and strategies for reaching these goals.

Grants are not made to or for any of the following purposes:

1. Individuals

2. Projects seeking to influence elections, political candidates or legislation.

Application Deadlines

There are two grant application deadlines a year:

March 1 and September 1.

To be considered, a proposal must be postmarked by the deadline date. When one of these dates falls on a weekend or holiday, the postmark may reflect the following business day. Applications sent by fax or email cannot be accepted.

Application Procedures

- 1. Review the Leightman Maxey Foundation purpose and geographical scope to determine if your charitable activity or organization meets these guidelines.
- Applicants must have received tax-exempt status as stated in Section 501(c)(3) and 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the equivalent for public entities.
- 3. Complete the grant application entirely. Do not exceed the space requirements for your answers on the grant application or use smaller than 10 font size.
- ${\tt 4.}$ Submit one original application with a brief cover letter and the following materials:

Detailed project/program or capacity building budget, if applicable. Include projected income sources and expenditures

Detailed agency budget for the current fiscal year

Most recent financial statement (from last completed fiscal year), audited if available

First page of the most recent IRS 990 + one complete copy (stapled) of the most recent 990 with ALL attachments, schedules & statements

Current list of Board members and their occupations

Proof of liability insurance

Board minutes acknowledging this grant application

Application Review

The Foundation will acknowledge each application received. During the grant review period, the Foundation may request an interview with, or a site visit to, the sponsoring agency in order to gain more information about the agency and its

proposal. Additional written material may also be requested. Throughout this time, applicants are encouraged to notify the Foundation of any changes in the status of the project under review, including its funding. Final grant decisions will be announced approximately 10-12 weeks after each deadline. The Foundation cannot expedite a funding decision. All applicants will be advised as to the outcome of their proposals. All decisions are final.

Grant awards are paid upon receipt of the signed grant agreement. Grantees must submit end of grant period reports. The Foundation must receive this report before considering any further grant applications from the same organization.

The Leightman Maxey Foundation endeavors to serve people throughout Southern Oregon. Despite this commitment, the foundation is unable to support every request received. Denial of a grant should not necessarily be considered a reflection on the quality of a project or the worthiness of an organization.

Grant Reporting

Every organization receiving a grant from the Leightman Maxey Foundation has a responsibility to report on the use of the funds granted. Reporting guidelines are provided with each of the Foundation's grant awards and can be found in detail on the Foundation's website. Unless otherwise indicated at the time disbursement is made, reports are required annually until the entire grant has been expended. The Foundation's Grants Advisory Committee values final reports and dedicates an entire meeting for their review. Failure to report as required by the Foundation could influence future grant decisions.
