In addition, OMCI has language written in their collection agency contract that states, "If the Agency learns a patient/debtor has neither sufficient income nor assets to meet his financial obligation, the Agency will not pursue collection activities against the patient/debtor, unless or until the Agency learns that the patient/debtor has income or assets to meet the obligation."

If individuals express a concern about being able to pay for services, they are offered an application for assistance and/or are referred to HRS/Erase to assist them in applying for disability, Medicaid, Crime Victim's compensation, etc., as appropriate. Our website contains instructions for applying for assistance as well as the forms in English and Spanish.
