Before the start of these deliberations, in keeping with Humanities Washington's Conflict of Interest Policy, a call is made for Executive Committee members to recuse themselves if there is an actual conflict of interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest of the individual, directly or indirectly, including through an immediate family member or member of the individual's household. Should any committee member or trustee have a conflict of interest or a potential conflict in writing and (b) shall not participate in any consideration and/or action by the Executive Committee as it relates to executive compensation. During these deliberations, the Executive Committee may consider input obtained from other board members, staff, professional advisors, grant recipients, and other informed community leaders. Once a consensus is reached regarding performance, a similar discussion is held concerning compensation relative to annual benchmark and established objectives. Salary surveys for similarly qualified persons in comparable positions at similarly situated organizations such as the bi-annual United Way of King County Wage & Benefit Survey and the annual Council Staff Salary Report published by the Federation of State Humanities Councils are used to determine compensation benchmarks for the position. Humanities Washington's other programs include an Exhibits Program which builds the capacity and audiences of small and rural museums by bringing them high-quality Smithsonian Institute Traveling Exhibits and technical assistance. In 2009, Humanities Washington toured the exhibit "Key Ingredients" to museums in La Conner, Richland, Renton, Metaline Falls, Yakima, Ilwaco and Kelso, serving more than 9500 people. In addition to exhibits, Humanities Washington distributes electronic and print publications which highlight cultural activities around the state. The organization also presents an annual event, Bedtime Stories, at which authors write original short stories and read them aloud at an event in Seattle. Finally, Humanities Washington partners with the Washington State Arts Commission and the Washington Poet's Association on the Washington State Poet Laureate program.
