# PRISON FELLOWSHIP INTERNATIONAL CORPORATE BYLAWS

#### as of 03 February 2009

#### Article I

#### **GENERAL**

#### Section 1 Name

The name of the corporation shall be Prison Fellowship International, hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation."

### Section 2 <u>Nonprofit Purposes</u>

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively as a volunteer nonprofit charitable and religious institution dedicated to the purposes stated in the articles of incorporation. The Board of Directors shall act to ensure that every officer, committee member, or employee of the Corporation is informed of the nature of and the purposes of this Corporation and is qualified and willing to render services consistent therewith.

## Section 3 Nonprofit Activities

No funds of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director or individual. No part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these bylaws, the Corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law) ("the Code"); or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 of the Code (or a successor statute of similar import).

# · Section 4 Regulation of Internal Affairs

The Corporation shall seek such sources of support, including the solicitation of grants from private units and direct or indirect contributions from the general public, as will enable it to qualify as a publicly supported organization as defined in Sections 170(b) (1) (A) (vi) and 509(a) (1) of the Code . However, for any period during which the Corporation is a "private foundation" as defined by Section 509 of the Code, the Corporation shall be subject to the following restrictions and prohibitions:

- (a) The Corporation shall make distributions for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not too become subject to the tax imposed on undistributed income by Section 4942 of the Code.
- (b) The Corporation shall not engage in any act of self dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code.
- (c) The Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings which will subject it to tax under Section 4943 of the Code.
- (d) The Corporation shall not make any investments in a manner such as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code.
- (e) The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditure as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code.

# Section 5 <u>Dissolution or Liquidation</u>

In the event of dissolution or final liquidation of the Corporation, none of the property of the Corporation nor any proceeds thereof shall be distributed to or divided among any of the directors or officers of the Corporation or inure to the benefit of any individual.

After all liabilities and obligations of the Corporation have been paid.

After all liabilities and obligations of the Corporation have been paid, satisfied and discharged, or adequate provisions made therefore, all remaining property and assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to one or more organizations designated (1) pursuant to a plan of distribution adopted as provided for in the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act or (2) if there be no appropriate plan of distribution, as a court, pursuant to the provisions of the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act, may direct; provided, however, such property shall be distributed only to organizations which shall comply with all of the following conditions:

- (a) Such organization shall be organized and operated exclusively for Christian charitable purposes and that the purposes shall be as closely aligned to those of the Corporation as possible.
- (b) Transfers of property to such organization shall, to the extent then permitted under the statutes of the United States, be exempt from Federal gift, succession, inheritance, estate or death taxes (by whatever name called).
- (c) Such organization shall be exempt from U.S. Federal income taxes by reason of Section 501 (c) (3) Code.
- (d) Contributions to such organization shall be deductible by reason of Section 170 of the Code of 1986.

#### Article II

## **OFFICES**

# Section 1 Registered Office and Agent

The Corporation shall continuously maintain a registered office and registered agent within the District of Columbia.

# Section 2 Principal Office

The principal office of the Corporation shall be located at such place as shall be determined by the Board of Directors.

## Section 3 Additional Offices

The Corporation may also have offices at such other places as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine and the business of the Corporation may require.

#### Article III

#### SEAL

The Corporation shall have a seal consisting of two concentric circles, between which shall be inscribed the name of the Corporation, and in the center of which shall be inscribed the year of its organization, and the words Corporate Seal, District of Columbia. Said seal may be used by causing it or a facsimile thereof to be impressed or affixed or otherwise reproduced.

### **Article IV**

## **BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

## Section 1 Number

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than five or more than nine persons.

# Section 2 Types and Number

## (a) Officers

There shall be a Chairperson, one or two Vice Chairpersons, a Secretary, Treasurer, and President. A Vice Chairperson may hold the position of Secretary or Treasurer concomitant with the position of Vice Chairperson. These officers shall be elected every two years by the Board of Directors.

# (b) At-Large

There may be up to four (4) additional members elected by the Board and designated as 'At-Large' members.

# Section 3 <u>Election and Term</u>

# (a) Officers

Officers shall be elected by the Board for a two year term. Officers are eligible for re-election.

# (b) At-Large Members

Members At-Large can be elected by the Board of Directors at any time for a term of two years or less, the exact term to be established at the time of election. At-large members are eligible for reelection.

# Section 4 <u>Vacancy</u>

If the office of a director becomes vacant a successor will be chosen by consent of the Board to fill the unexpired term of office.

## Section 5 Powers

The property, affairs and business of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors, which may exercise all such powers of the Corporation and do all such lawful acts and things as are not by statute or by the articles of incorporation or by these bylaws prohibited.

## Section 6 Committees

The Board of Directors may appoint two or more persons from among its own number to serve as special and standing committees, such as the Board may determine are necessary, which shall have such powers and duties as shall from time to time be prescribed by the Board. All actions by any Board committee shall be reported to the Board of Directors at the meeting next succeeding such action.

## Section 7 Removal

Any director may be removed with or without cause by a majority vote of the directors at any meeting duly called and at which a quorum is present, and the remaining directors may thereupon elect a successor or successors to fill any resulting vacancy for the unexpired term of any removed director.

## Section 8 Transactions with Interested Directors

No contract or other transaction between the Corporation and one or more of its directors or any other corporation, firm, association or entity of which one or more of its directors are directors or officers or in which such persons are financially interested, shall be either void or voidable because of such relationship or interest or because such director or directors are present at the meeting of the Board of Directors or a committee thereof which authorizes, approves or ratifies such contract or transaction or because his or their votes are counted for such purpose, if either of the following conditions is met:

- (a) The fact of such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the Board of Directors or committee which authorizes, approves, or ratifies the contract or transaction by a vote or consent sufficient for the purpose without counting the votes or consents of such interested directors; or
- (b) The contract or transaction is fair and reasonable to the Corporation.

Common or interested directors may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the Board of Directors or a committee thereof, which authorizes, approves or ratifies such contract or transaction.

Notwithstanding the above, no loan shall be made by the Corporation to any of its directors or officers.

# Section 9 <u>Compensation of Directors</u>

Directors and members of any committee of the Board of Directors shall not be entitled to any compensation for their services, as such, but shall be entitled to reimbursement for any reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of the corporation.

#### Article V

## **TRUSTEES**

### Section 1

A Vice Chairperson of the Board of Directors shall be elected by the Board of Directors to preside as chairperson of the Board of Trustees for the Association of Chartered Prison Fellowship Ministries.

#### Section 2

The Board of Trustees shall be responsible for the chartering, rechartering, and de-chartering of members in accordance with the charter

policies determined by the Board of Directors. The Board of Trustees shall be responsible for membership and membership bodies including the General Assembly and Regional Assemblies as defined in the By-laws of the Board of Trustees.

### Section 3

Decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be promptly reported to the Board of Directors, and shall be subject to its review and approval within a reasonable time. No decision of the Board of Trustees can supersede rights and privileges designated solely to the Board of Directors of the Corporation.

#### Section 4

The Board of Trustees shall be responsible for advising the Board of Directors concerning membership development, chartering, membership services and ministry issues.

### Section 5

The members of the Board of Trustees shall include two members of the Board of Directors; the elected Chairperson from each of the Regional Assemblies (Africa, Asia, Europe, Latin America, North America & Caribbean, Pacific, and Middle East); and up to three at large members elected by the Board of Trustees. The President of the Corporation shall serve as ex-officio member.

## Section 6

Each member of the Board of Trustees shall be elected for a term of four years and shall be eligible for two consecutive terms before being required to stand down.

### Section 7

The Board of Trustees shall meet twice yearly with one of the two meetings being convened jointly with a meeting of the Board of Directors.

#### Article VI

### MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

## Section 1 Notice

Regular and special meetings of the Board may be held with or without notice at such time and place, either within or outside the District of Columbia, as shall from time to time be determined by the Board. The Board of Directors shall meet three or four times yearly with one meeting being held conjointly with the Board of Trustees.

## Section 2 Waiver

Whenever any notice is required to be given under the provisions of the statutes or of the articles of incorporation, or by these bylaws, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to said notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent thereto. Attendance at a meeting by a person entitled to notice shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except where attendance is for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

## Section 3 Quorum

A simple majority of the directors shall be necessary and sufficient to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the act of a majority of the directors shall be the act of the Board of Directors, except as may be otherwise specifically provided by statute or by the Articles of Incorporation or by these bylaws.

# Section 4 Action Without a Meeting

Any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors or by a committee thereof may be taken without a meeting, by means of telephone, mail, telegram, e-mail, cable or in any other way the directors shall decide. However, a written consent setting forth the action so taken and signed by all the members of the Board or of a committee, as the case may be, must be filed with the minutes of proceedings of the Board or the Committee.

# Section 5 Participation by Conference Telephone

Members of the Board of Directors or of any committee designated thereby may participate in a meeting of such Board or committee by means of a conference telephone or similar communications equipment whereby all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at such meeting. When such a meeting is conducted by means of a conference telephone or similar communications equipment, a written record shall be made of the action taken at such meeting.

#### Article VII

### CORPORATE OFFICERS

## Section 1 Number and Positions

The officers of the Corporation shall be elected by the Board of Directors and shall be the Chairperson, President, Vice Chairpersons, Secretary and Treasurer. The Board of Directors may also elect Vice Presidents and one or more Assistant Secretaries and Assistant Treasurers. Two or more offices may be held by the same person except that the offices of the Chairperson and Secretary may not be held by the same person. The Board may appoint such other officers and agents as it shall deem necessary, who shall hold their offices for such terms and shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as shall be determined from time to time by the Board.

## Section 2 Terms of Office

The officers shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors. If the office of any officer becomes vacant for any reason, the vacancy shall be filled by the Board of Directors. In case of the absence or disability of an officer of the Corporation, or in any other case that the Board of Directors may deem sufficient reason therefore, the Board of Directors, by a majority vote, may delegate for the time being any or all of the powers or duties of any officer to any other officer, director or any other person.

# • Section 3 The Chairperson

The Chairperson shall preside at all Board meetings and shall make reports to the Board of Directors, and shall have such other rights, duties, and powers as are authorized by the Board of Directors.

## Section 4 The President

The President shall be the chief executive officer of the Corporation, and shall be salaried and shall be responsible for the day to day management of the Corporation and the supervision of its staff. The President shall be responsible to the Chairperson and the Board to carry out its policies, plans, and objectives. The President may be dismissed by the Board with or without cause, but without prejudice to any contract rights to which he or she may be entitled. The President's performance and compensation shall be assessed annually by the Chairman and a committee of the Board designated for that purpose.

# Section 5 The Vice Chairpersons

One of the Vice Chairpersons, or in the absence of the Vice Chairpersons, any other Board member nominated by the Board shall in the absence or disability of the Chairperson, or upon delegation by the Chairperson, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the Chairperson, or such of them as may be so delegated, and shall perform such other duties or exercise such powers as the Board of Directors shall prescribe.

# Section 6 The Secretary

The Secretary or an Assistant Secretary shall attend all meetings of the Board, and record all votes and the minutes of all proceedings in a book to be kept for that purpose, and shall perform like duties for the standing committees when required. The Secretary shall give, or cause to be given, such notice as is required of all meetings of the Board of Directors, and shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors or Chairperson. The Secretary shall keep in safe custody the seal of the Corporation and, when authorized by the Board, affix the same to any instrument requiring it, and when so affixed, it shall be attested by his signature or by the signature of the Treasurer or an Assistant Secretary. To the extent permitted by law, the Secretary may delegate any responsibility established in this Section or otherwise placed on the position to any Assistant Secretary.

## Section 7 <u>Assistant Secretaries</u>

The Assistant Secretaries in order of their seniority shall, in the absence or disability of the Secretary, or to discharge any delegation made by the Secretary, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the Secretary and shall perform such other duties as the Board of Directors shall prescribe.

## Section 8 The Treasurer

Except as the Board of Directors may otherwise determine, the Treasurer shall deliver all funds and securities of the Corporation to such bank or trust company as the directors shall designate as a depository, and shall keep full and accurate accounts of receipts and disbursements in books belonging to the Corporation. The Treasurer shall disburse the funds of the Corporation as may be ordered by the Board, taking proper vouchers for such disbursements, and shall render to the Chairperson and Directors, at the regular meetings of the Board, or whenever they may require it, an account of all his transactions as Treasurer and of the financial condition of the Corporation. If required by the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall give the Corporation a bond in such sum and with such surety or sureties as shall be satisfactory to the Board for the faithful performance of the duties of the office and for the restoration to the Corporation, in case of death, resignation, retirement or removal from office, of all books, papers, vouchers, money and other property of whatever kind of possession or under the control of the Treasurer, belonging to the Corporation. To the extent permitted by law, the Treasurer may delegate any responsibility established in this Section or otherwise placed on him to any Assistant Treasurer.

## Section 9 Assistant Treasurers

The Assistant Treasurers in the order of their seniority shall, in the absence or disability of the Treasurer, or to discharge any delegation made by the Treasurer, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the Treasurer and shall perform such other duties as the Board of Directors shall prescribe.

### Article VIII

### INDEMNIFICATION OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

Each director or officer and each former director or officer and his heirs, executors, and administrators (hereinafter referred to as Corporate Agent) may be indemnified by the Corporation against reasonable costs and expenses incurred by him in connection with any claim, action, suit or proceeding to which he may be made a party by reason of his being or having been a director or officer of the Corporation, except in relation to any actions, suits or proceedings in which he shall be adjudged liable because of willful misfeasance, bad faith, gross negligence, or reckless disregard of the duties involved in the conduct of his office. In the absence of an adjudication which expressly absolves a Corporate Agent of liability to the Corporation arising from allegations of willful misfeasance, bad faith, gross negligence, or reckless disregard of the duties involved in the conduct of his office, or in the event of a court approved settlement, each Corporate Agent may be indemnified by the Corporation against payments made, including reasonable costs and expenses, provided that such indemnification shall be conditioned upon the prior determination by a resolution of two-thirds of those members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation who are not involved in the action, that the director or officer has no liability by reason of willful misfeasance, bad faith, gross negligence, or reckless disregard of the duties involved in the conduct of his office, and provided further that if a majority of the members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation are involved in the action, such determination shall have been made by a written opinion of independent counsel. Amounts paid in settlement shall not exceed costs, fees, and expenses, which would have reasonably been incurred if the action, suit or proceeding had been litigated to a conclusion. The foregoing rights and indemnification shall not be exclusive of any other rights to which said Corporate Agent may be entitled according to the law. The Corporation may at any time through action of its Board of Directors obtain appropriate indemnification insurance, to insure itself against any liability which may arise under this Article.

#### Article IX

### FISCAL MATTERS

# Section 1 Deposits

The Board of Directors shall, or shall delegate to the President/CEO the authority to, select banks, trust companies, or other depositories in which

all funds of the Corporation not otherwise employed shall, from time to time, be deposited to the credit of the Corporation.

### Section 2 Checks

All checks or demands for money and notes of the Corporation shall be signed by such officer or officers or such other person or persons as the Board of Directors may from time to time designate.

## Section 3 <u>Fiscal Years</u>

The Board of Directors shall have the power to fix, and from time to time change, the fiscal year of the Corporation. Unless otherwise fixed by the Board, the fiscal year shall commence on January 1 and shall terminate on the following December 31.

#### Article X

#### AFFILIATE NATIONAL MINISTRIES

# Section 1 Application and Conditions

- (a) The Board of Directors is solely responsible for establishing the policies and conditions governing the affiliation of national PF ministries with Prison Fellowship International. A national entity involved in prison ministry may apply to the Corporation for affiliation and the granting of a charter and limited license to use the name, logo, and programme trademarks of Prison Fellowship and Prison Fellowship International.
- (b) To be granted a charter, the national entity must meet all requirements of chartering and make application to the Board of Trustees which is responsible for membership (affiliation & chartering) under the authority of the Board of Directors.
- (c) The charter granted for a national organization to operate as a Prison Fellowship ministry shall be granted for an initial period of two years, renewable for four year periods thereafter, and shall include a limited license to use the name "Prison Fellowship" and the corporate logo in accordance with the chartering covenants. A chartered national entity shall be designated a chartered 'Prison Fellowship National Ministry.'

(d) The Board of Trustees may recommend to the Board of Directors that the charter of any Prison Fellowship National Ministry that fails to comply with the charter requirements set by the Board of Directors be terminated. However, termination shall not be effective until approved by the Board of Directors.

## NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION

The Board of Directors shall act to ensure that no decision in the selection, treatment, retention or dismissal of any officer, committee member, or employee of the Corporation is based on such person's age, sex, race, skin color, or nationality.

#### **Article XIII**

#### **AMENDMENTS**

These bylaws may be amended, altered or repealed by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Directors at any regular meeting of the Board or at any special meeting of the Board if notice of the proposed alteration or repeal is contained in the notice of such meeting.
